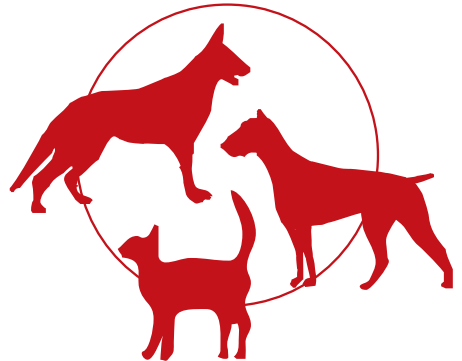


**Vaccinate
your dogs and cats
against rabies**



BECAUSE

- ▶ rabies kills people and animals
- ▶ you get rabies when an infected animal bites you





Vaccination prevents **RABIES!**



When to vaccinate your dog and cat

- ▶ **First vaccination**
3 months old
- ▶ **First booster**
1 to 9 months after first
vaccination
- ▶ **Follow-up boosters**
at least every 3 years



Movement control

- ▶ When moving dogs and
cats from one province to
another you need
 - a valid rabies vaccination
certificate, or
 - a rabies vaccination
declaration by the owner



Where to get vaccine for dogs and cats

- ▶ Veterinary clinic or
hospital
- ▶ Pharmacy
- ▶ Farmers' cooperatives
- ▶ Animal welfare
organisations
- ▶ Veterinarian or animal
health technician
