Some General Information on the Aquaculture certificate programme:

1. The minimum requirement for the Certificate programme is Matric without exemption (Grade 12) or equivalent with Biology as a subject.
2. The certificate students do not get a Student Number with the university, as they are enrolling with the department and not through the normal university system. They are however able to gain access to the University Library as external users. This course is accredited by SAQA with a NQF level = 6 and 12 credits at the SU.
3. The certificate course as well as the course material is presented in English. Students are very welcome to answer exams and tasks in Afrikaans or English.
4. All the lectures for the modules mentioned in the runner are available on video cassette and DVD. Live satellite classes take place when student numbers are above a minimum of 3 per study venue nationally.
5. The course fee includes all study material and postage costs.
6. An examination fee of R450.00 will be charged per exam. All students write an exam in June (Module I to Module III) and November (Module IV to Module VI + Assignment) and therefore pay a R900.00 examination fee. All re-write will also cost a further R450.00 per exam.
7. The full course fee is R8 500 (R7 600.00 for course fees and R900.00 for 2 exams). A payment of R4250, 00 is required by 31 January to confirm enrolment.
8. I will sent you a Tax Invoice for half of the course fee of R4 250,00 in December 2011/January 2012.
The outstanding amount of R4250,00 will be payable by 15 July 2012. Please take note that should you need to re-write any of the exams, a further charge of **R450.00 per exam** will be payable before your certificate is issued.
9. You will find all the banking details on the Tax Invoice.
10. The course fees include all study materials, courier costs, first and second semester exam fee (not re-writes) as well as the issue of your certificate for a successful result. The study materials will be sent to you in mid February 2012 and end of July 2012.
