On 27 June 2021, President Cyril Ramaphosa announced that the country would shift to adjusted Lockdown Level 4 (from 28 June to 11 July). In light of this, the following decisions have been taken:

- All invigilated first examination sessions will continue on campus until Wednesday, 30 June 2021.
- All scheduled supplementary examinations will be deferred to a later date, prior to the commencement of the second semester. The new, amended supplementary timetable will be communicated to all students at a later stage.
- The scheduled Winter School for all students registered for the final year Diploma in Agriculture: Work Integrated Learning Programme has been postponed. The new dates will be communicated to all students at a later stage.
