

# PORK MONTHLY REPORT



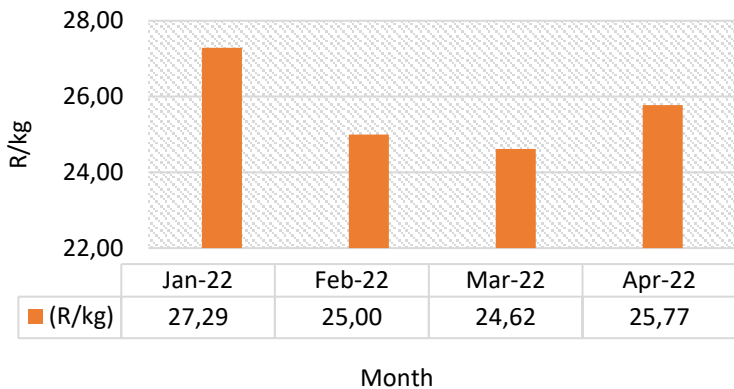
## Issue: 2022/04

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of pork carcasses excluding value added tax.

During the reporting period, April 2022, average local pork prices increased from prices recorded in March 2022. When comparing year on year prices, there is decrease in local pork prices in April 2022 compared to the same period last year.

### Bacon pig price trend: (R/kg)



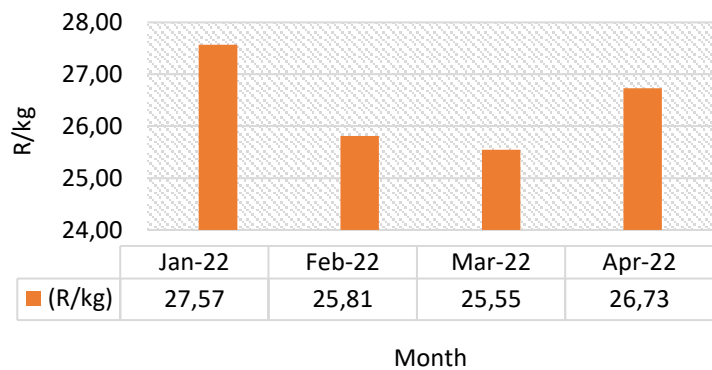
### Bacon Price trend

- In April 2022, the average price for bacon pigs was R25, 77 per kg, which is 5% higher than in March 2022.
- Year on year average prices for bacon pigs decreased by 11 % in April 2022 compared to April 2021.

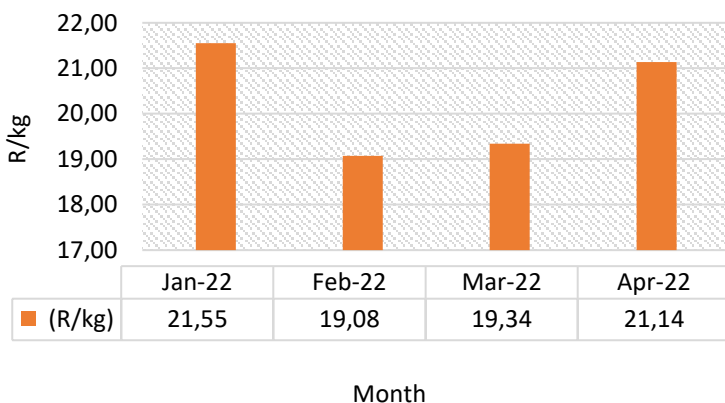
### Porker Price trends

- In April 2022, the average price for porkers was R26, 73 per kg, which is 5 % higher than in March 2022.
- Year on year average prices for porkers are showing a decrease of 12% between April 2021 and April 2022.

### Sausage pig Price trend

- During April 2022, average price for sausage pig was R21, 14 per kg, which is a 9 % price increase from March 2022.
- Year on year sausage pig showed 13% average price decrease compared to same period last year.
