

# **MUTTON MONTHLY REPORT**




Issue: 2022/04

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer prices (R/kg) of mutton and feeder lambs excluding value added tax.

During the reporting period, April 2022, average local mutton prices (except for class C) have increased from prices recorded in March 2022. When comparing year on year prices, there is an increase in local mutton prices in April 2022 compared to the same period last year.





## Mutton Class A2/3 Price trend

- In April 2022, the average price for Class A Mutton was R94, 62 per kg which is 11, 6 % higher than in March 2022.
- Year on year average prices for Class A increased by 13, 9 % in April 2022 compared to April 2021.

## Mutton Class B2/3 Price trend

- In April 2022, the average price for mutton Class B was recorded to be R74,
   65 per kg, which is 0, 1 % higher than in March 2022.
- Year on year average prices for Class B are showing an increase of 11, 6% between April 2021 and April 2022.






## Mutton Class C2/3 Price trend

- During April 2022, average price for class C Mutton was R69, 74 per kg, which is a 1,9 % price decrease when compared to March 2022.
- Year on year Class C Mutton showed
  8,2% average price increase compared to
  same period last year.

#### **Lamb Price trend**

- In April 2022, the average price for Lamb was R44, 12 per kg, which is 3, 5
   % higher than in March 2022.
- Year on year average prices in April
  2022 were 5, 5% higher than last year during the same period.
