

PORK MONTHLY REPORT



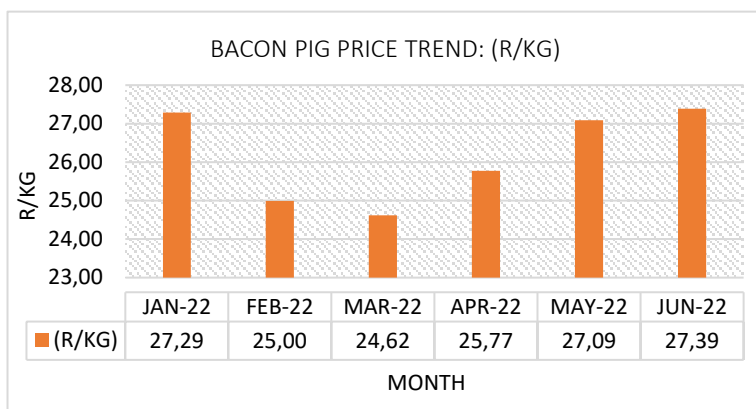

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of pork carcasses excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Pork - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg

During the reporting period, June 2022, average local pork prices (except for sausage pigs) increased from prices recorded in May 2022. When comparing year on year prices, local pork prices decreased in June 2022 compared to the same period last year.

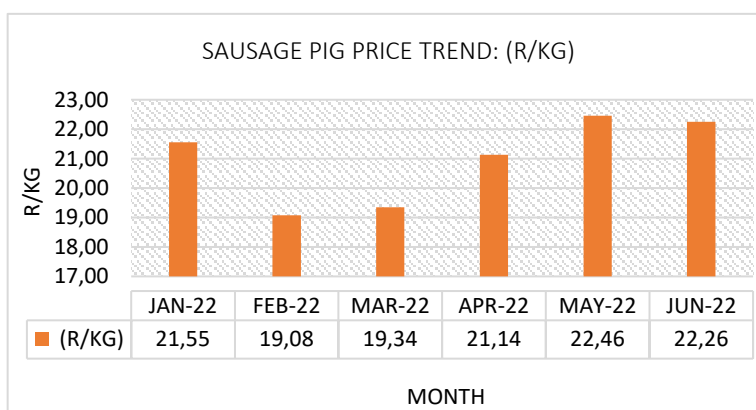
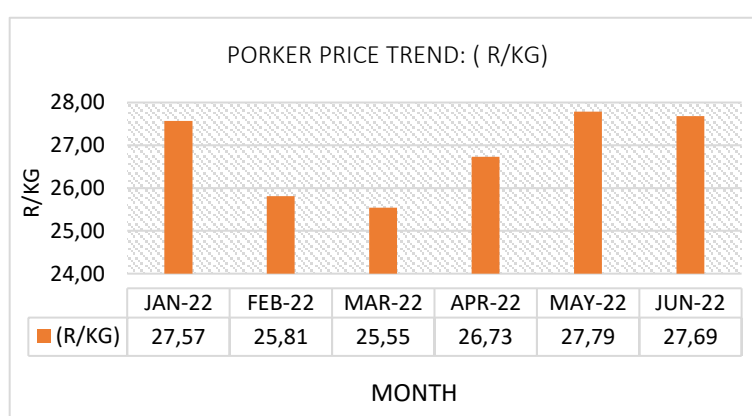


Bacon price trend

- In June 2022, the average price for bacon pigs was R27, 39 per kg, which is 1% higher than in May 2022.
- Year on year average prices for bacon pigs decreased by 3 % in June 2022 compared to June 2021.

Porker price trend

- In June 2022, the average price for porkers was R27, 69 per kg, which is 0,4% lower than in May 2022.
- Year on year average prices for porkers are showing a decrease of 8% between June 2021 and June 2022.



Sausage pig price trend

- During June 2022, average price for sausage pig was R22, 26 per kg, which is a 1% price decrease from May 2022.
- Year on year sausage pig showed 5% average price decrease compared to same period last year.
