

# BEEF MONTHLY REPORT



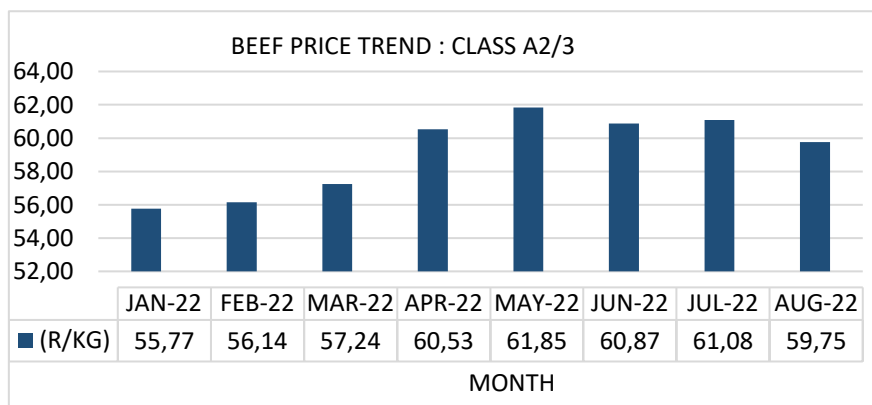
## Issue: 2022/08

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of beef and weaner calves excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Beef- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg

During the reporting period, August 2022, average local beef prices were lower (except for Class B2/3 prices) than prices recorded in July 2022. When comparing year-year prices, there is an increase in local beef (except for weaner) prices in August 2022 compared to the same period last year.

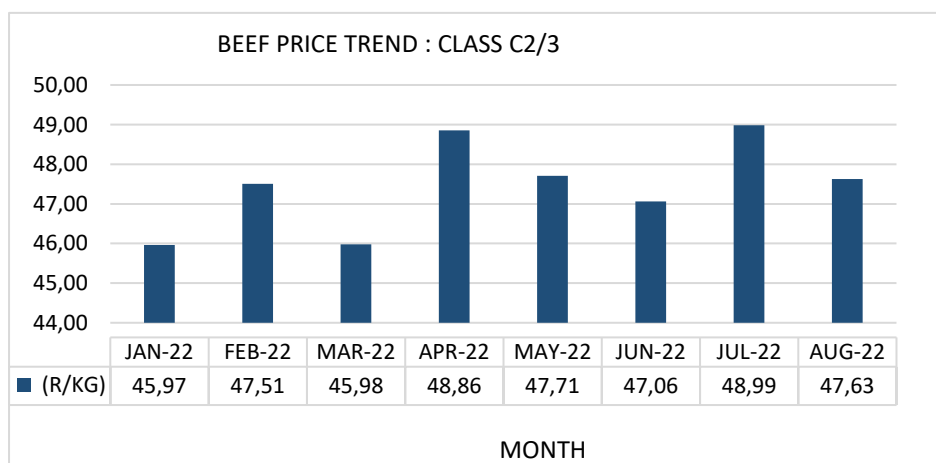
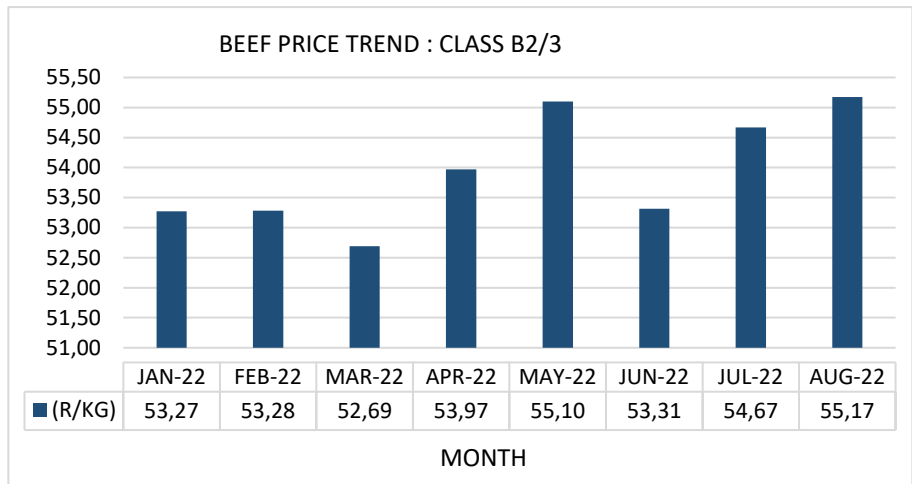


### Beef Price trend: Class A2/3

- In August 2022, the average price for Class A beef was R59,75 per kg which is 2,18% lower than in July 2022.
- Year on year average prices for Class A increased by 15,35% in August 2022 compared to August 2021.

### Beef Price trend: Class B2/3

- In August 2022, the average price for Class B was recorded to be R55, 17 per kg, which is 0, 92 % higher than in July 2022.
- Year on year average prices for Class B are showing an increase of 8, 02% between August 2021 and August 2022.

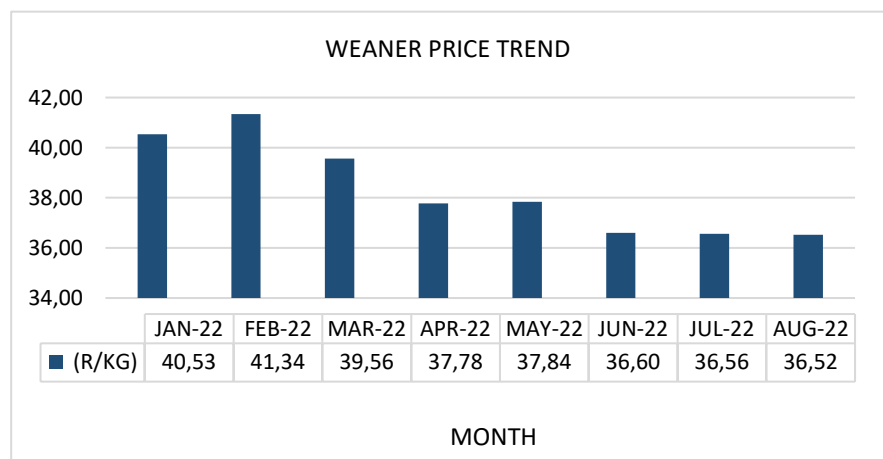


### Beef Price trend: Class C2/3

- During August 2022, average price for class C beef was R47, 63 per kg, which is a 2, 78 % price decrease from July 2022.
- Year on year Class C beef showed 1, 14 % average price increase compared to same period last year.

### Weaner Price trend

- In August 2022, the average price for weaner calves was R36, 52 per kg, which is 0, 10 % lower than in July 2022.
- Year on year average prices in August 2022 were 3, 60 % lower than last year during the same period.
