

BEEF MONTHLY REPORT





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of beef and weaner calves excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Beef- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg

During the reporting period, July 2022, average local beef prices were higher (except for weaner prices) than prices recorded in June 2022. When comparing year-year prices, there is an increase in local beef prices in July 2022 compared to the same period last year.





Beef Class A2/3 Price trend

- o In July 2022, the average price for Class A beef was R61, 08 per kg which is 0, 34 % higher than in June 2022.
- Year on year average prices for Class A increased by 46, 33 % in July 2022 compared to July 2021.

Beef Class B2/3 Price trend

- In July 2022, the average price for Class B was recorded to be R54, 67 per kg, which is 2, 54 % higher than in June 2022.
- Year on year average prices for Class B are showing an increase of 33, 43% between July 2021 and July 2022.






Beef Class C2/3 Price trend

During July 2022, average price for class C beef was R48, 99 per kg, which is a 4, 09 % price increase from June 2022.
Year on year Class C beef showed 27, 58 % average price increase compared to same period last year.

Weaner Price trend

- In July 2022, the average price for weaner calves was R36, 56 per kg, which is 0, 13 % lower than in June 2022.
- Year on year average prices in July 2022 were 19, 43 % higher than last year during the same period.
