

BEEF MONTHLY REPORT





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of beef and weaner calves excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Beef- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg

During the reporting period, May 2022, average local beef prices (except for C2 class) were higher than prices recorded in April 2022. When comparing year-year prices, there is an increase in local beef prices (except for weaner prices) in May 2022 compared to the same period last year.





Beef Class A2/3 Price trend

- In May 2022, the average price for Class A beef was R61, 85 per kg which is 2, 17 % higher than in April 2022.
- Year on year average prices for Class A increased by 16, 37% in May 2022 compared to May 2021.

Beef Class B2/3 Price trend

- In May 2022, the average price for Class B was recorded to be R55, 10 per kg, which is 2, 09 % higher than in April 2022.
- Year on year average prices for Class B are showing an increase of 9, 55% between May 2021 and May 2022.





Beef Class C2/3 Price trend

- During May 2022, average price for class C beef was R47, 71 per kg, which is a 2, 35 % price decrease from April 2022.
- Year on year Class C beef showed 1,73% average price increase compared to same period last year.

Weaner Price trend

- In May 2022, the average price for weaner calves was R37, 84 per kg, which is 0, 17 % lower than in April 2022.
- Year on year average prices in May 2022 were 1, 49 % lower than last year during the same period.
