

PORK MONTHLY REPORT





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of pork carcasses excluding value added tax.

During the reporting period, August 2022, average local prices for pork (except for bacon pigs) decreased from prices recorded in July 2022. When comparing year on year prices, local pork prices (except for pork pigs) increased in August 2022 compared to the same period last year.




Bacon price trend


In August 2022, the average price for bacon pigs was R27, 55 per kg, which is 0, 2% higher than in July 2022.

 Year on year average prices for bacon pigs increased by 8, 8% in August 2022 compared to August 2021.

Porker price trend

- In August 2022, the average price for porkers was R25, 96 per kg, which is 4, 3 % lower than in July 2022.
- Year on year average prices for porkers are showing a decrease of 4 % between August 2021 and August 2022.





Sausage pig price trend

 During August 2022, average price for
sausage pig was R21, 78
per kg, which is a 0, 7%
price decrease from
July 2022.
Year on year sausage
pig showed 5, 1 %
average price increase
compared to same
period last year.
