

GOAT MONTHLY REPORT



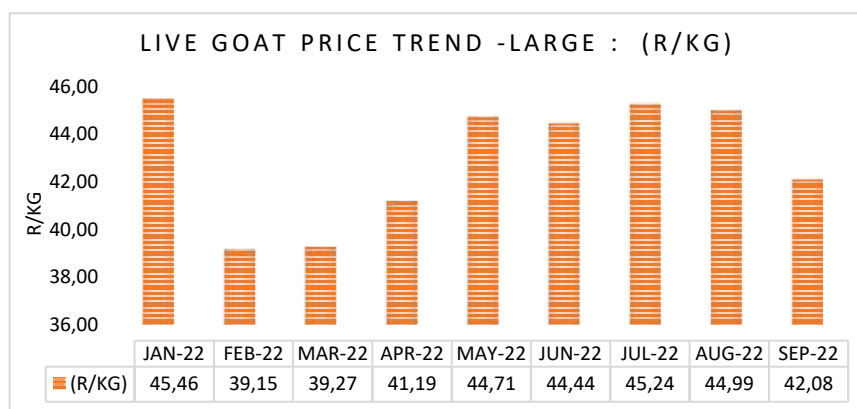

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of live goats excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Live goat- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg

During the reporting period, September 2022, average local prices for live goats decreased from prices recorded in August 2022. When comparing year on year prices, there was an increase in local goat prices (except for medium goats) in September 2022 compared to September 2021.

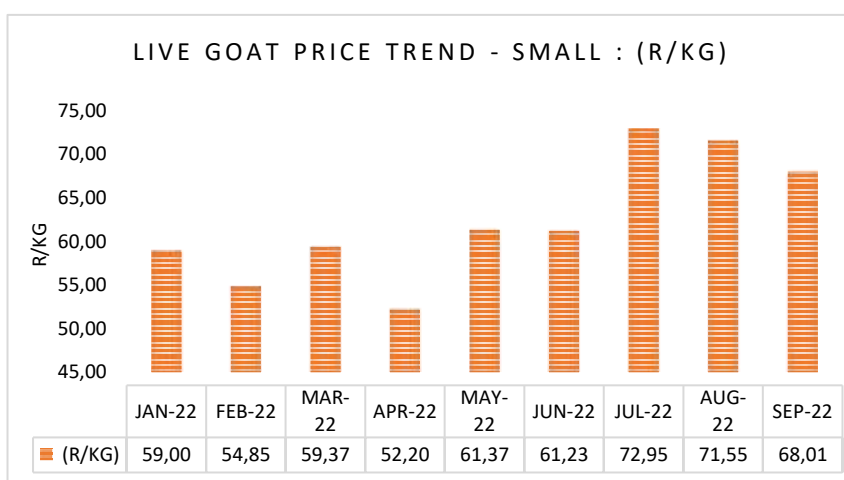
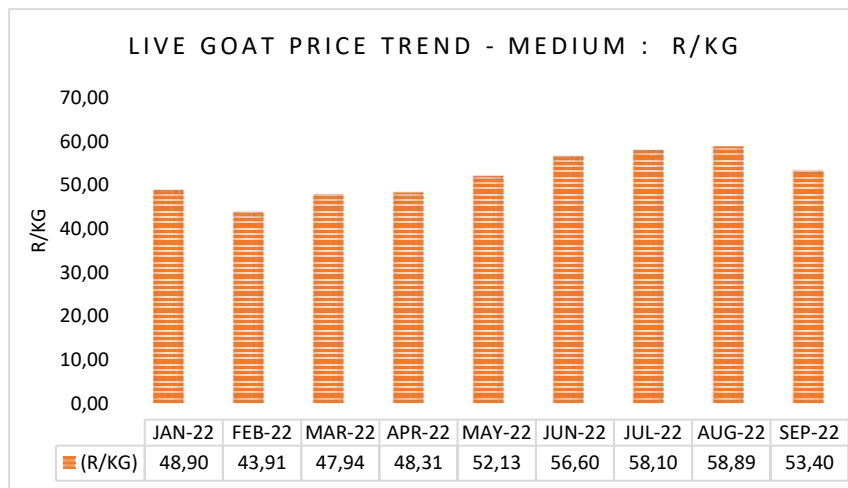


Large goat price trend

- In September 2022, the average price for a large goat was R42,08 per kg, which is 6,5% lower than in August 2022.
- Year on year average prices for a large goat increased by 3% in September 2022 compared to September 2021.

Medium goat price trend

- In September 2022, the average price for a medium goat was R53, 40 per kg, which is 9, 3 % lower than in August 2022.
- Year on year average prices for a medium goat show a decrease of 1, 4 % between September 2021 and September 2022.

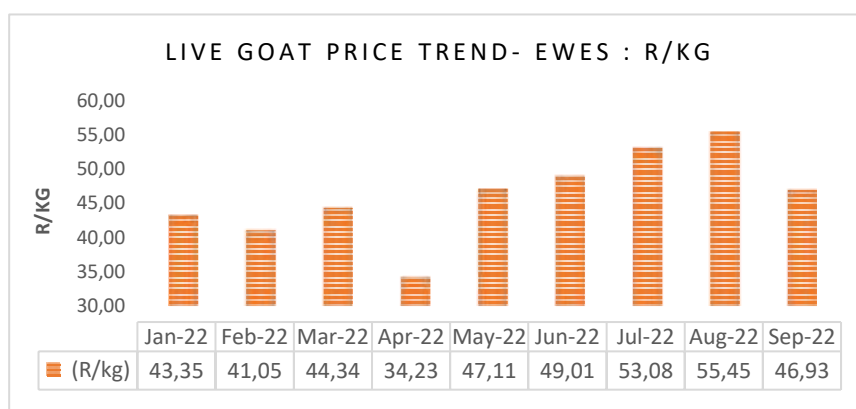


Small goat price trend

- During September 2022, average price for a small goat was R68, 01 per kg, which is 4, 9 % price decrease from August 2022.
- Year on year small goat showed a 1, 6% average price increase compared to the same period last year.

Live goat price trend (Ewes)

- In September 2022, the average price for ewes was R46, 93 per kg, which is 15, 4 % lower than in August 2022.
- Year on year average prices in September 2022 were 4, 5% higher than last year during the same period.
