

# PORK MONTHLY REPORT



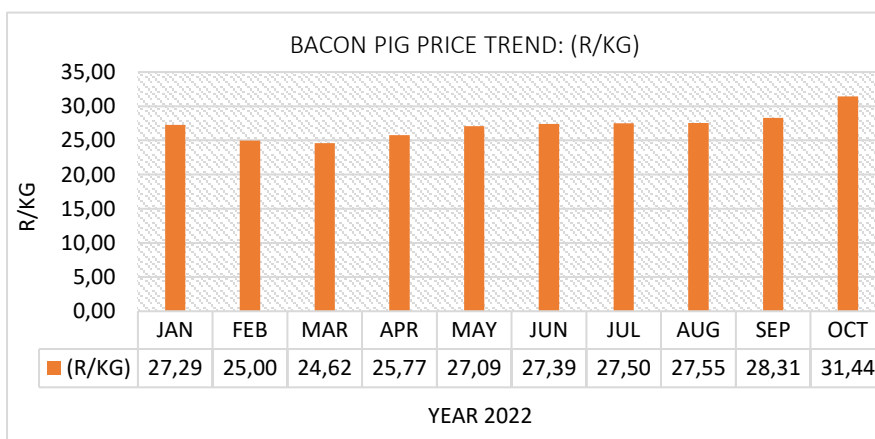
## Issue: 2022/10

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of pork carcasses excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Pork - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg

During the reporting period, October 2022, average local prices for pork increased from prices recorded in September 2022. When comparing year on year prices, local pork prices increased in October 2022 compared to the same period last year.

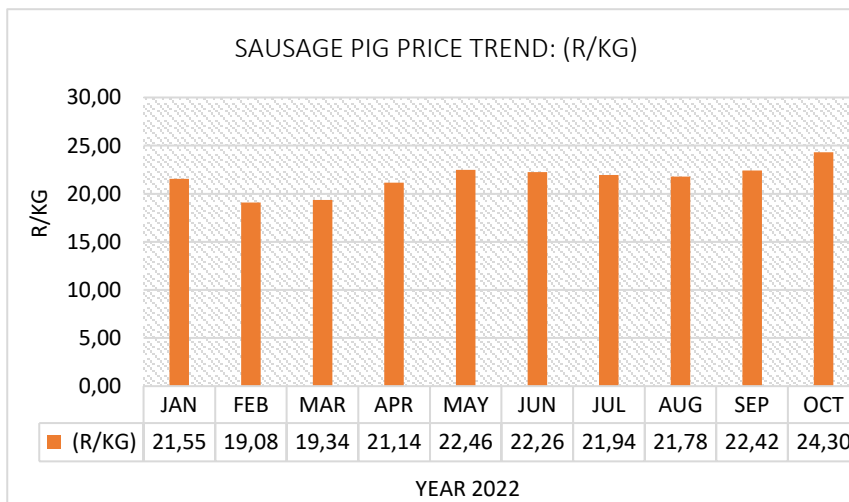
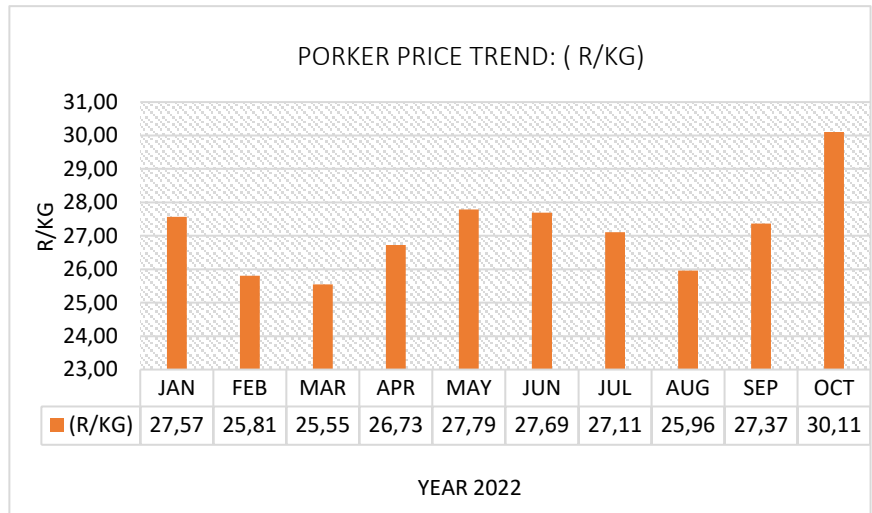


### Bacon price trend

- In October 2022, the average price for bacon pigs was R31, 44 per kg, which is 11, 1% higher than in September 2022.
- Year on year average prices for bacon pigs increased by 18, 5% in October 2022 compared to October 2021.

### Porker price trend

- In October 2022, the average price for porkers was R30, 11 per kg, which is 10 % higher than in September 2022.
- Year on year average prices for porkers are showing an increase of 8, 2 % between October 2021 and October 2022.



### Sausage pig price trend

- During October 2022, average price for sausage pig was R24, 30 per kg, which is an 8, 4 % price increase from September 2022.
- Year on year sausage pig showed 9, 3 % average price increase compared to the same period last year.
