

# GOAT MONTHLY REPORT



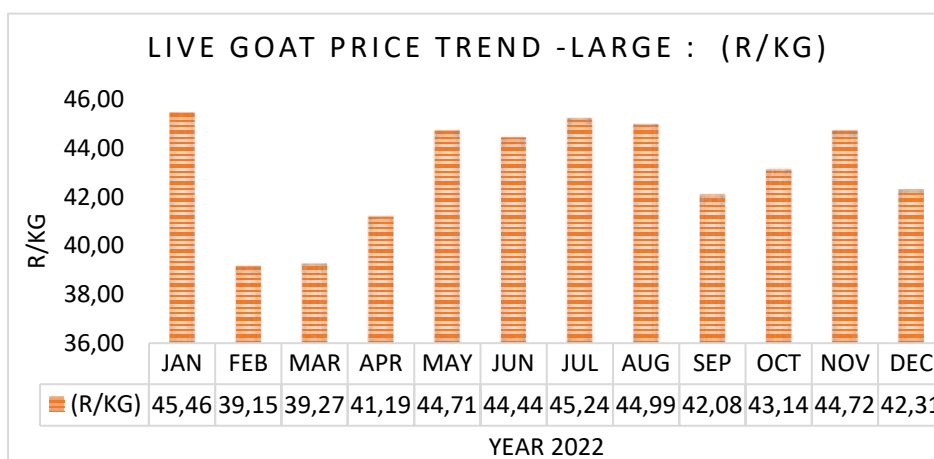
## Issue: 2022/12

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of live goats excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Live goat- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg

During the reporting period, December 2022, average local prices for live goats decreased (except for ewes) from prices recorded in November 2022. When comparing year on year prices, there was a decrease in local goat prices (except for ewes) in December 2022 compared to December 2021.

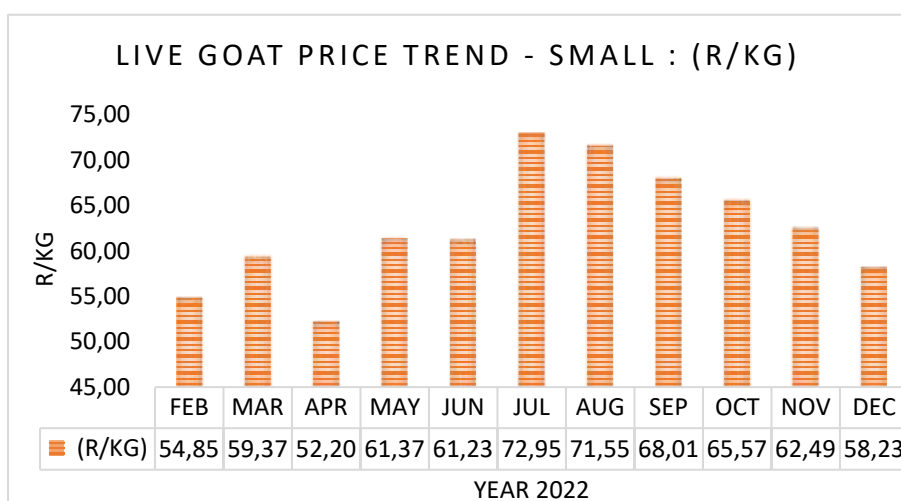
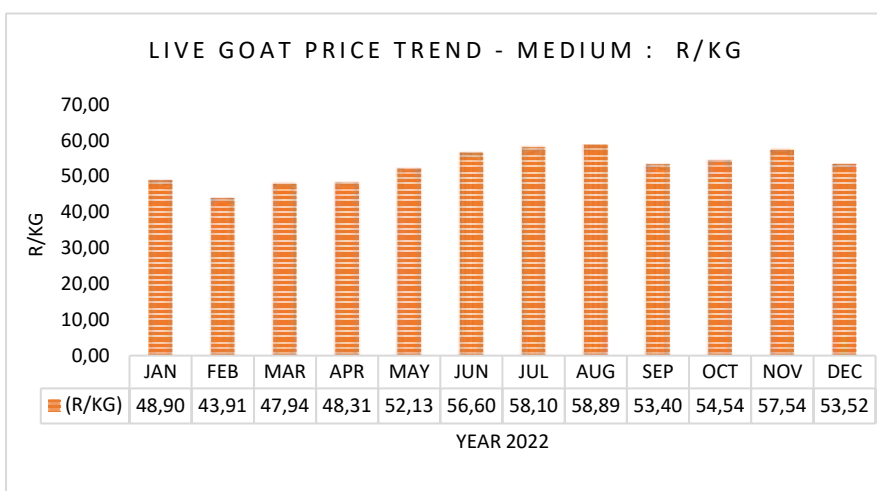


### Large goat price trend

- In December 2022, the average price for a large goat was R42, 31 per kg, which is 5, 4 % lower than in November 2022.
- Large goat prices increased by 3,6 % in December 2022 compared to December 2021.

### Medium goat price trend

- In December 2022, the average price for a medium goat was R53, 52 per kg, which is 7 % lower than in November 2022.
- Year on year average prices for a medium goat show an increase of 2,3 % between December 2021 and December 2022.

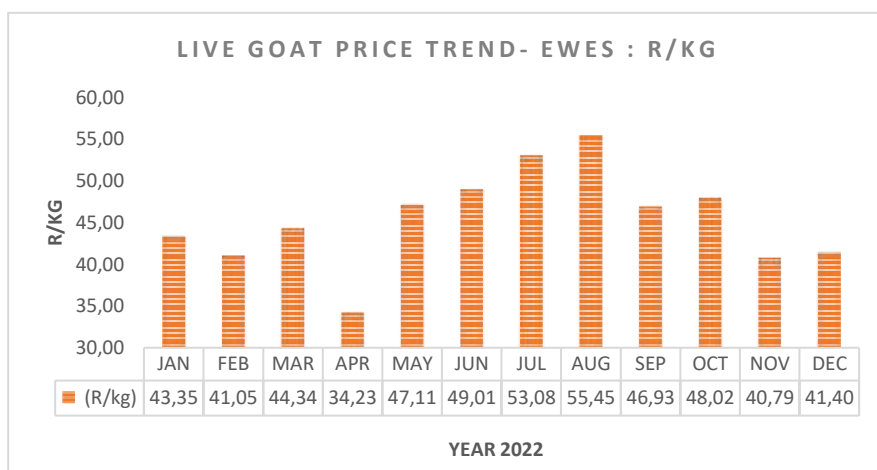


### Small goat price trend

- During December 2022, average price for a small goat was R58, 23 per kg, which is a 6, 8 % price decrease from November 2022.
- Year on year small goat showed a 3,1 % average price decrease compared to the same period last year.

### Live goat price trend (Ewes)

- In December 2022, the average price for ewes was R41, 40 per kg, which is 1,5 % higher than in November 2022.
- Year on year average prices in December 2022 were 5,2% lower than last year during the same period.
