

# PORK MONTHLY REPORT



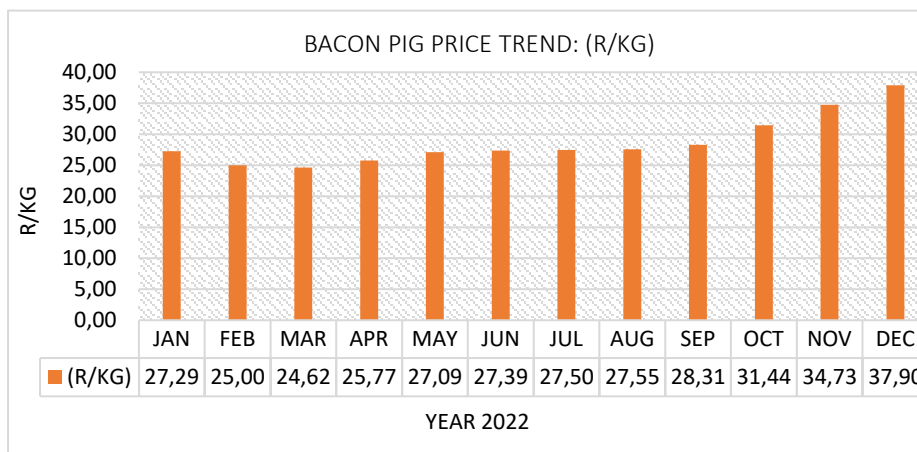
## Issue: 2022/12

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of pork carcasses excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Pork - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg

During the reporting period, December 2022, average local prices for pork increased from prices recorded in November 2022. When comparing year on year prices, local pork prices increased in December 2022 compared to the same period last year.

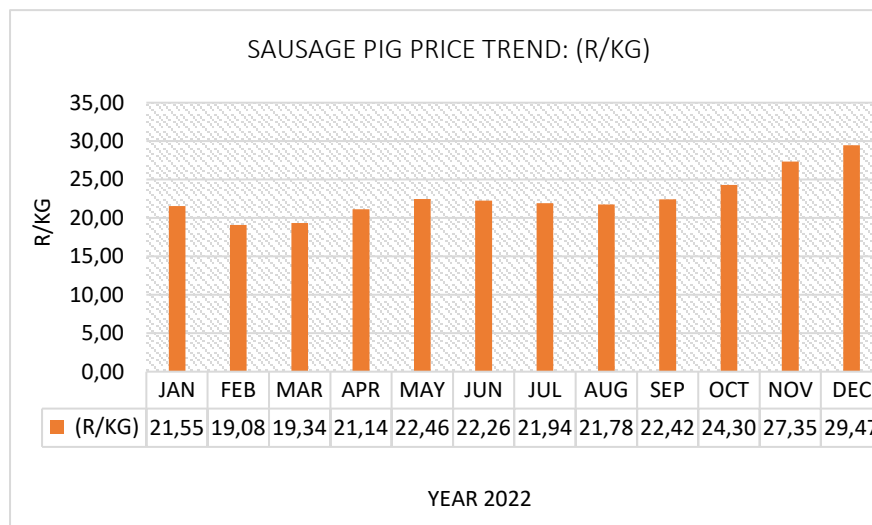
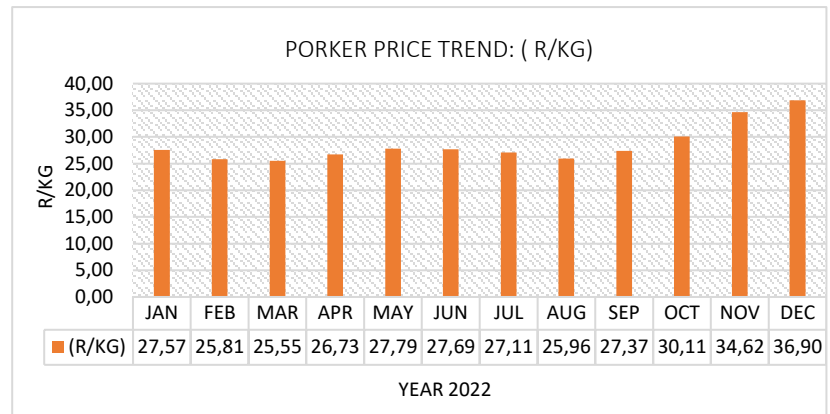


### Bacon price trend

- In December 2022, the average price for bacon pigs was R37, 90 per kg, which is 9, 1% higher than in November 2022.
- Year on year average prices for bacon pigs increased by 32, 9 % in December 2022 compared to December 2021.

### Porker price trend

- In December 2022, the average price for porkers was R36, 90 per kg, which is 6,6 % higher than in November 2022.
- Year on year average prices for porkers are showing an increase of 24, 5 % between December 2021 and December 2022.



### Sausage pig price trend

- During December 2022, average price for sausage pig was R29, 47 per kg, which is a 7, 8 % price increase from November 2022.
- Year on year sausage pig showed 25, 4 % average price increase compared to the same period last year.
