

BEEF MONTHLY REPORT





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of beef and weaner calves excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Beef- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg

During the reporting period, January 2023, average local beef prices were higher (except for weaner) than prices recorded in December 2022. When comparing year-year prices, there is an increase in local beef (except for weaner) prices in January 2023 compared to the same period last year.





Beef Price trend: Class A2/3

In January 2023, the average price for Class A beef was R59, 35 per kg which is 0, 23 % higher than in December 2022.
Year on year average prices for Class A increased by 6, 42 % in January 2023 compared to January 2022.

Beef Price trend: Class B2/3

- In January 2023, the average price for Class B was recorded to be R55, 73 per kg, which is
 6, 24 % higher than in December 2022.
- Year on year average prices for Class B are showing an increase of 4, 62 % between January 2023 and January 2022.





Beef Price trend: Class C2/3

During January 2023, average price for class C beef was R51,
92 per kg, which is a 4, 57 % price increase from December 2022.

Year on year Class C beef
 showed 12, 96 % average price
 increase compared to same
 period last year.

Weaner Price trend

- In January 2023, the average price for weaner calves was R36, 95 per kg, which is 0, 08 % lower than in December 2022.
- Year on year average prices in January 2023 were 8, 84 % lower than last year during the same period.
