Taking pet dogs and cats overseas

If your situation differs in any way from the proposed process or if you have information from the veterinary authority of the importing country that differs from the process described below, please contact your local state veterinarian to discuss the matter.

Exporters are advised to verify the requirements of the importing country by contacting the veterinary authorities, or their representatives in South Africa, in advance of each consignment.

Requirements

- An import permit from the country you are going to (some countries such as EU countries and Namibia do not issue these, for further information contact your local State Vet)
 - a. The import permit will list any specific tests, vaccinations or treatments that your pet needs to undergo. The correct timing of these is imperative.
- A health check within 7 days of travel depending on what is specified on the import permit

Procedure

- Your pet should be taken to your local private veterinarian for a health check.
- Your veterinarian should complete a standard Veterinary Health Certificate (VHC). Blank forms may be obtained from the State vet (SV) office.
- Your veterinarian must have completed all the tests, treatments and vaccinations indicated on the import permit. Any of these that were not performed by the veterinarian (Unless exception is specifically stated on the import permit) will not be acceptable for certification purposes
- The signed VHC, import permit as well as your pet's vaccination booklet and supporting documents should be brought to the SV office for certification. You should also have your driver's licence or ID book available.
- Certificate application cost can be found on the departments tariff register (Cost for application in 2023 is R200 each) each payable on appointment.
