

GOAT MONTHLY REPORT





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of live goats excluding value added tax.

During the reporting period, February 2023, average local prices for live goats decreased from prices recorded in January 2023. When comparing year on year prices, there was a decrease in local goat prices (except for medium and small goats) in February 2023 compared to February 2022.



Large goat price trend

In February 2023, the average price for a large goat was
R34, 80 per kg, which is 18, 1 %
lower than in January 2023.

Large goat prices decreased
 by 11, 1 % in February 2023
 compared to February 2022.



Medium goat price trend

In February 2023, the average price for a medium goat was R44,
99 per kg, which is 18,4 % lower than in January 2023.

 Year on year average prices for a medium goat show an increase of 2, 5% between February 2022 and February 2023.

Small goat price trend

 During February 2023, average price for a small goat was R55, 07 per kg, which is a 16, 1 % price decrease from January 2023.

 Year on year small goat showed a 0, 4 % average price increase compared to the same period last year.





Live goat price trend (Ewes)

In February 2023, the average price for ewes was R36, 04 per kg, which is 13, 6 % lower than in January 2023.

 Year on year average prices
 in February 2023 were 12,2 %
 lower than last year during the same period.
