This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of live goats excluding value added tax.

During the reporting period, June 2023, average local prices for live goats (except for large goats and ewes) increased from prices recorded in May 2023. When comparing year on year prices, there was a decrease in local goat prices in June 2023 compared to June 2022.




Large goat price trend


- In June 2023, the average price for a large goat was R42, 69 per kg, which is 4, 1 % lower than in May 2023.
- Large goat prices decreased by 3, 9 % in June 2023 compared to June 2022.

Medium goat price trend

- In June 2023, the average price for a medium goat was R52, 15 per kg, which is 4 % higher than in May 2023.
- Year on year average prices for a medium goat show a decrease of 7, 9 % between June 2022 and June 2023.



LIVE GOAT PRICE TREND - SMALL




Small goat price trend

- During June 2023, average price for a small goat was R54, 22 per kg, which is a 2, 6 % price increase from May 2023.
- Year on year small goat prices showed a 11, 4 % average price decrease compared to the same period last year.

Live goat price trend (Ewes)

- In June 2023, the average price for ewes was R40, 77 per kg, which is 2, 3 % lower than in May 2023.
- Year on year average prices in June 2023 were 16, 8 % lower than the previous year during the same period.
