

PORK MONTHLY REPORT



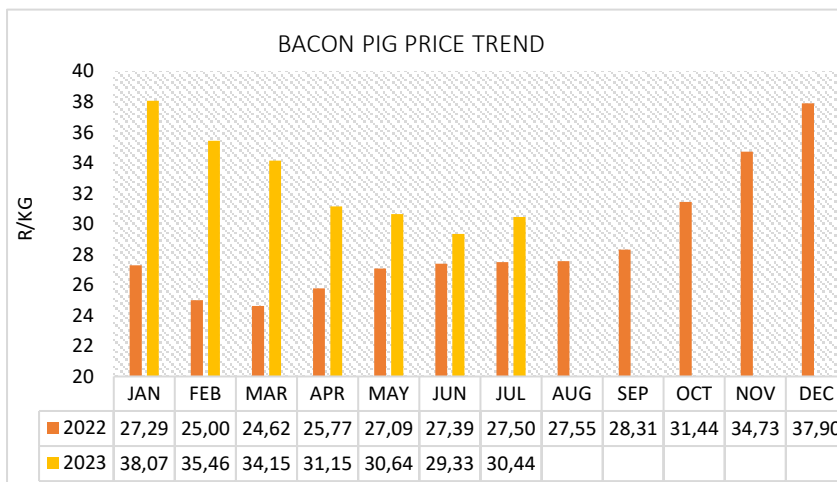

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of pork carcasses excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Pork - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg

During the reporting period, July 2023, average local prices for pork (except for pork pigs) increased from prices recorded in June 2023. When comparing year on year prices, local pork prices increased in July 2023 compared to the same period last year.

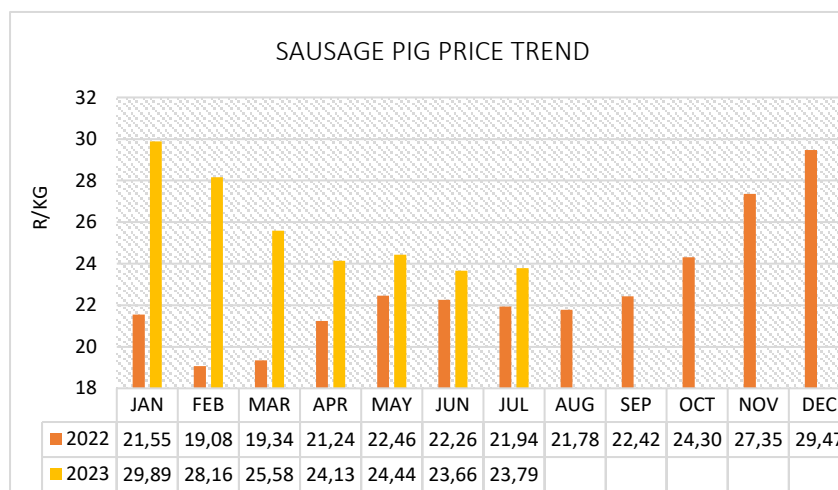
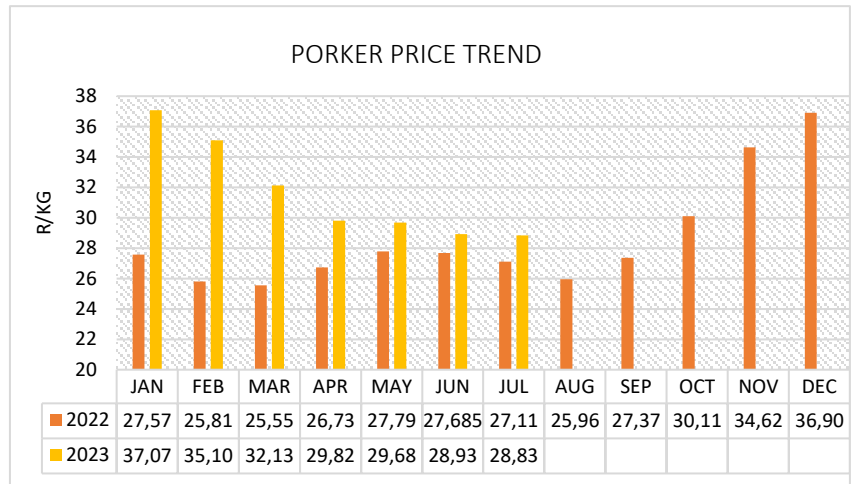


Bacon price trend

- In July 2023, the average price for bacon pigs was R30, 44 per kg, which is 3, 8 % higher than in June 2023.
- Year on year average prices for bacon pigs increased by 10, 7 % in July 2023 compared to July 2022.

Porker price trend

- In July 2023, the average price for porkers was R28, 83 per kg, which is 0, 4 % lower than in June 2023.
- Year on year average prices for porkers are showing an increase of 6, 3 % between July 2022 and July 2023.



Sausage price trend

- In July 2023, average price for sausage pig was R23, 79 per kg, which is a 0, 5 % price increase from June 2023.
- Year on year average prices for sausage pig show an 8, 4 % increase compared to the same period last year.
