

MUTTON MONTHLY REPORT





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer prices (R/kg) of mutton and feeder lambs excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Mutton - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

During the reporting period, November 2023, average local prices for mutton increased (except for storage lamb) from prices recorded in October 2023. When comparing year on year prices, there is a decrease in local prices for mutton in November 2023 compared to the same period last year.





Class A2/3 Price trend

- In November 2023, the average price for Class A Mutton was R84,53 per kg which is 1,3% higher than in October 2023.
- Year on year average prices for Class A decreased by 6,3% in November 2023 compared to November 2022.

Class B2/3 Price trend

- In November 2023, the average price for mutton Class B was recorded to be R63,68 per kg, which is 6,7 % higher than in October 2023.
- Year on year average prices for Class B are showing a decrease of 13,5 % between November 2022 and November 2023.






Class C2 / 3 Price trend

- During November 2023, average price for Class C was R61,06 per kg, which is a 4 % price increase when compared to October 2023.
- Year on year Class C prices showed a 12,7 % average price decrease compared to same period last year.

Storage Lamb Price trend

- In November 2023, average price for Storage Lamb was R37,77 per kg, which is 2,5 % lower than in October 2023.
- Year on year average prices in November 2023 were 7,5 % lower than last year during the same period.
