

GOAT MONTHLY REPORT



Issue: 2024/01

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of live goats excluding value added tax.

During the reporting period, January 2024, average local prices for live goats from prices recorded in December 2023. When comparing year on year prices, there was a decrease (except for large goats) in local goat prices in January 2024 compared to January 2023.



Large goat price trend

In January 2024, the average price for a large goat was R43,44 per kg, which is 9,5 % lower than in December 2023.

Large goat prices increased
by 2,2% in January 2024
compared to January 2023.

Medium goat price trend

- In January 2024, the average price for a medium goat was R37,26 per kg, which is 21 % lower than in December 2023.
- Year on year average prices for a medium goat show a decrease of 32,4 % between January 2023 and January 2024.






Small goat price trend

 During January 2024, average price for a small goat was
R46,79 per kg, which is a 11,5 % price decrease from December 2023.

Year on year small goat
prices showed an 28,7 % average
price decrease compared to the
same period last year.

Live goat price trend (Ewes)

- In January 2024, the average price for ewes was R37,52 per kg, which is 1,7 % lower than in December 2023.
- Year on year average prices in January 2024 were 10 % lower than the previous year during the same period.
