

PORK MONTHLY REPORT





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of pork carcasses excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Pork - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

During the reporting period, January 2024, average local prices for pork decreased from prices recorded in December 2023. When comparing year on year prices, local pork prices decreased in January 2024 compared to the same period last year.





Bacon price trend

- In January 2024, the average price for bacon pigs was R32,66 per kg, which is 7,8 % lower than in December 2023.
- Year on year average prices for bacon pigs decreased by 14,2 % in January 2024 compared to January 2023.

Porker price trend

- In January 2024, the average price for porkers was R33,09 per kg, which is 7,7 % lower than in December 2023.
- Year on year average prices for porkers are showing a decrease of 10,7 % between January 2023 and January 2024.





Sausage price trend

- In January 2024, average price for sausage pig was R24,40 per kg, which is an 8,1 % price decrease from December 2023.
- Year on year average prices for sausage pig show a 18,4 % decrease compared to the same period last year.
