

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of poultry excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Poultry - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

During the reporting period, December 2023, average local poultry prices increased from prices recorded in November 2023. When comparing year-year prices, there is an increase in local poultry prices in December 2023 compared to the same period last year.





Frozen poultry price trend

- o In December 2023, average price for Frozen poultry was R38,30 per kg, which is 1,4 % higher than in November 2023.
- Year on year average prices for Frozen poultry increased by 18,8% in December 2023 compared to December 2022.

Fresh poultry price trend

- In December 2023, the average price for Fresh poultry was R38,68 per kg, which is 2,3 % higher than in November 2023.
- Year on year average prices for Fresh poultry are showing an increase of 15,7% between December 2022 and December 2023.





IQF poultry price trend

- o During December 2023, average price for IQF poultry was R34, 26 per kg, which is a 0,5 % price increase from November 2023.
- Year on year IQF poultry showed 7,8% average price increase compared to same period last year.
