

# GOAT MONTHLY REPORT




## Issue: 2024/04

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of live goats excluding value added tax.

During the reporting period, April 2024, average local prices for live goats increased from prices recorded in March 2024. When comparing year on year prices, there was an increase (except medium and small goats) in local goat prices in April 2024 compared to April 2023.




### Large goat price trend

• In April 2024, the average price for a large goat was R44,46 per kg, which is 3,3 % higher than in March 2024.

 Large goat prices increased by 12,5% in April 2024 compared to April 2023.

#### Medium goat price trend


- In April 2024, the average price for a medium goat was R43,34 per kg, which is 10,2% higher than in March 2024.
- Year on year average prices for a medium goat show a decrease of 8,2% between April 2023 and April 2024.



#### Small goat price trend

 During April 2024, average price for a small goat was R45,98 per kg, which is a 0,6% price increase from March 2024.

 Year on year small goat prices showed a 13,8% average price decrease compared to the same period last year.



#### Live goat price trend (Ewes)

- In April 2024, the average price for ewes was R42,44 per kg, which is 10,5 % higher than in March 2024.
- Year on year average prices in April 2024 were 11,3 % higher than the previous year during the same period.
