

GOAT MONTHLY REPORT





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of live goats excluding value added tax.

During the reporting period, July 2024, average local prices for live goats increased (except large goats) from prices recorded in June 2024. When comparing year on year prices, there was an increase (except medium goats) in local goat prices in July 2024 compared to July 2023.




Large goat price trend


 In July 2024, the average price for a large goat was R51,45 per kg, which is 0,1 % lower than in June 2024.

Large goat prices increased by
21,6 % in July 2024 compared to July
2023.

Medium goat price trend

- In July 2024, the average price for a medium goat was R46,62 per kg, which is 8,4% higher than in June 2024.
- Year on year average prices for a medium goat show a decrease of 3,9% between July 2023 and July 2024.






Small goat price trend

 During July 2024, average price for a small goat was R59,43 per kg, which is a 4,7% price increase from June 2024.

 Year on year small goat prices showed a 2,7% average price increase compared to the same period last year.

Live goat price trend (Ewes)

- In July 2024, the average price for ewes was R44,74 per kg, which is 8,9 % higher than in June 2024.
- Year on year average prices in July 2024 were 0,1 % higher than the previous year during the same period.
