





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer prices (R/kg) of mutton and feeder lambs excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Mutton - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

During the reporting period, August 2024, average local prices for mutton increased (except class B and storage lamb) from prices recorded in July 2024. When comparing year on year prices, there is a decrease (except class C and storage lamb) in local prices for mutton in August 2024 compared to the same period last year.





Class A2/3 Price trend

- In August 2024, the average price for Class A Mutton was R89,55 per kg which is 1,8% higher than in July 2024.
- Year on year average prices for Class A increased by 2,7% in August 2024 compared to July 2023.

Class B2/3 Price trend

- In August 2024, the average price for mutton Class B was R66,34 per kg, which is 0,1% lower than in July 2024.
- Year on year average prices for Class B are showing an increase of 0,2% between July 2023 and August 2024.




Class C2 / 3 Price trend

- During August 2024, average price for Class C was R64,68 per kg, which is a 2,9% price increase when compared to July 2024.
- Year on year Class C prices decreased by 2,6% in August 2024 compared to July 2023.

Storage Lamb Price trend

- In August 2024, average price for Storage Lamb was R40,10 per kg, which is 2,3% lower than in July 2024.
- Year on year average prices in August 2024 were 3,8 % lower than last year during the same period.
