

# MUTTON MONTHLY REPORT




## Issue: 2024/09

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer prices (R/kg) of mutton and feeder lambs excluding value added tax.

During the reporting period, September 2024, average local prices for mutton in decreased (except class A) from prices recorded in August 2024. When comparing year on year prices, there is an increase in local prices for mutton in September 2024 compared to the same period last year.




### Class A2/3 Price trend


 In September 2024, the average price for Class A Mutton was R90,59 per kg which is 1,2% higher than in August 2024.

Year on year average prices for
 Class A increased by 6,6% in
 September 2024 compared to
 August 2023.

#### Class B2/3 Price trend

- In September 2024, the average price for mutton Class B was R62,41 per kg, which is 3,2% lower than in August 2024.
- Year on year average prices for Class B are showing an increase of 1,3% between August 2023 and September 2024.






#### Class C2 / 3 Price trend

 During September 2024, average price for Class C was R62,85 per kg, which is a 2,8% price decrease when compared to August 2024.

Year on year Class C prices
increased by 3,1% in September
2024 compared to August 2023.

#### **Storage Lamb Price trend**

- In September 2024, average price for Storage Lamb was R39,58 per kg, which is 1,3% lower than in August 2024.
- Year on year average prices in September 2024 were 1,7 % higher than last year during the same period.
