

POULTRY MONTHLY REPORT





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of poultry excluding value added tax.

During the reporting period, September 2024, average local poultry prices increased from prices recorded in August 2024. When comparing year-year prices, there is a decrease in local poultry prices in September 2024 compared to the same period last year.



Frozen poultry price trend


 In September 2024, average price for Frozen poultry was R35,38 per kg, which is 0,9% higher than in August 2024.


Year on year average prices for
Frozen poultry decreased by 0,3% in
September 2024 compared to
September 2023.

Fresh poultry price trend

In September 2024, the average price for Fresh poultry was R33,98 per kg, which is 0,8% higher than in August 2024.

Year on year average prices for
Fresh poultry are showing a
decrease of 2,3% between
September 2023 and September
2024.





IQF poultry price trend

 During September 2024, average price for IQF poultry was
R31, 03 per kg, which is a 4,2% price increase from August 2024.

• Year on year IQF poultry showed a 6,3% average price decrease compared to same period last year.
