## This initiative targets:

- Scholars at agricultural schools (grade 8-12) and scholars in mainstream schools (grade 10-12) with mathematics and science subjects.
- Undergraduate students studying towards qualifications in the agricultural fields listed below.

The bursary/scholarship will partly/fully cover tuition/school fees, accommodation, books, meals and an allowance where applicable. The bursaries/scholarships target previously disadvantaged and impoverished people from poverty-stricken and rural communities. Persons with a disability are encouraged to apply.
