# POWER OUTAGE RESPONSE FOR THE AGRICULTURAL SECTOR



#### FOR FARMERS AND AGRI-WORKERS

- It is important to ensure that your workspace is properly ventilated during loadshedding.
- It is equally important to take the necessary precautions, particularly during winter when using candles and open fires, as there is an increased risk when using open flames.
- Ensure that all fires and candles are extinguished before going to bed or leaving the workplace.
- Ensure that no fire is left unattended.
- Opt for battery-operated lighting or PV-charged where possible.
- Generators should be kept in well-ventilated areas as they release poisonous gases when running.
- The noise of generators due to the noise decibels can also cause hearing damage if placed too close to a workstation for a prolonged period.

#### **ON THE FARM**

- Identify your energy/electricity needs and understand which of these needs are the more critical one i.e. if you only have limited backup power during load shedding /an outage, what should this be used for, in other words, do an energy assessment of your farm.
- Ensure that you have an alternative energy supply to minimise losses, specifically if you have equipment that requires electricity. This is particularly important for the animal production industry, whilst agri-processing industries can also be gravely impacted.
- Ensure that you back-up your computer and other tools used for data collection and make sure cellphones are always charged.
- Switching off appliances and equipment to reduce energy usage and to minimises the possibility of damage caused by the regular power surges.
- Insurance on equipment and property to protect you from unplanned expenses.
- Ensure that you have alternative measures in place for the care of animals when mechanised feeders are not operational during load shedding.
- Ensure that you have a sufficient supply of water and food for animals.
- Clean water should be made available to all livestock to ensure animal health.
- Ensure that adequate quantities of diesel for generators are stored safely.
- Ensure that you monitor the movement around the farm as these is a higher risk of attempted theft and farm attacks during load shedding/power outages.
- If you are not already on a farmer group in your area, join one in order to be able to support one another. Be in close communication with your neighbours to create a safety network.
- Create an emergency response plan for your farm consisting of emergency contact numbers.

# POWER OUTAGE RESPONSE FOR THE AGRICULTURAL SECTOR

- Replace your regular bulbs with rechargeable light bulbs.
- Solar powered lights are a good investment given the large amount of sunshine hours in the Western Cape.
- · Generators.
- Inverters.
- Gas geysers.
- Portable power banks.
- Surge resistant/protector plugs.
- Uninterruptable power supply (UPS) allows you to power various devices, from IP cameras to routers.
- The trusty flask to keep water warm for longer.
- Portable thermos cooler, e.g. wonderbag that can help keep food cold or warm.

Consider keeping meals simple and sufficient for a day or two to reduce the requirement to store leftovers. In order to avoid having spoilt food causing food poisoning or to waste food because it is unfit for human consumption.

As we head into the colder and wetter winter season, let's be mindful of these tips to ensure a safer and more sustainable agricultural sector.
