

PORK MONTHLY REPORT





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of pork carcasses excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Pork - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

During the reporting period, October 2024, average local prices for pork increased from prices recorded in September 2024. When comparing year on year prices, local pork prices decreased in October 2024 compared to the same period last year.





Bacon price trend

- o In October 2024, the average price for bacon pigs was R32,78 per kg, which is 1,7% higher than in September 2024.
- Year on year average prices for bacon pigs decreased by 11,7% in October 2024 compared to October 2023.

Porker price trend

- In October 2024, the average price for porkers was R33,32 per kg, which is 2,1% higher than in September 2024.
- Year on year average prices for porkers are showing a decrease of 11,9% between October 2023 and October 2024.





Sausage pig price trend

o In October 2024, average price for a sausage pig was R25,26 per kg, which is a 0,8% price increase from September 2024.

 Year on year average prices for a sausage pig show a 7,6% decrease compared to the same period last year.
