

# PORK MONTHLY REPORT





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of pork carcasses excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Pork - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

During the reporting period, January 2025, average local prices for pork decreased from prices recorded in December 2024. When comparing year on year prices, local pork prices decreased (except for sausage pig ) in January 2025 compared to the same period last year.





#### **Bacon price trend**

- o In January 2025, the average price for bacon pigs was R32,37 per kg, which is 0,4% lower than in December 2024.
- Year on year average prices for bacon pigs decreased by 0,9% in January 2025 compared to January 2024.

### Porker price trend

- In January 2025, the average price for porkers was R32,68 per kg, which is 0,8% lower than in December 2024.
- Year on year average prices for porkers are showing a decrease of 1,2% between January 2024 and January 2025.





## Sausage pig price trend

o In January 2025, average price for a sausage pig was R25,97 per kg, which shows a 2,6% price decrease from December 2024.

 Year on year average prices for a sausage pig show a 6,4% increase compared to the same period last year.
