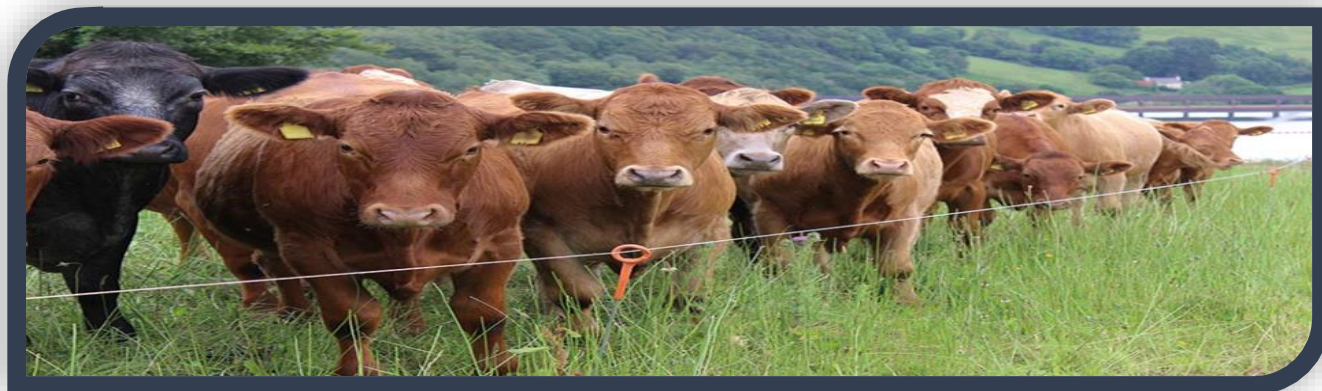


# BEEF MONTHLY REPORT



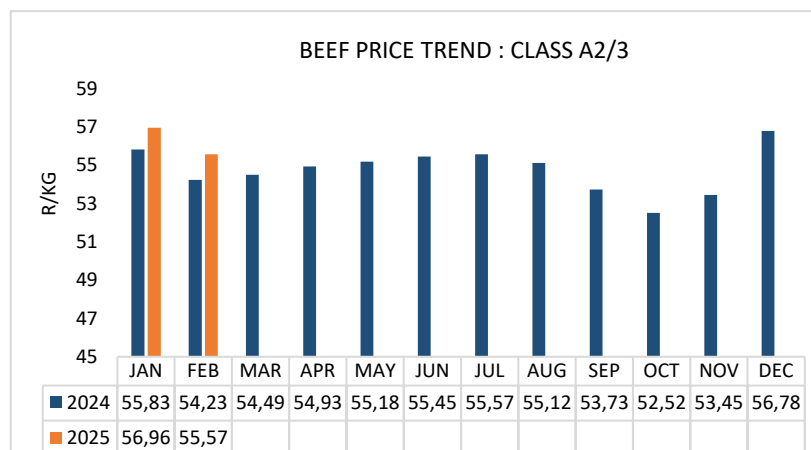
## Issue: 2025/02

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of beef and weaner calves excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Beef- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

During the reporting period, February 2025, average local beef prices were lower (except for class B and weaner prices) than prices recorded in the previous month. February 2025 local beef prices show an increase (except for weaner prices) compared to the same period last year.

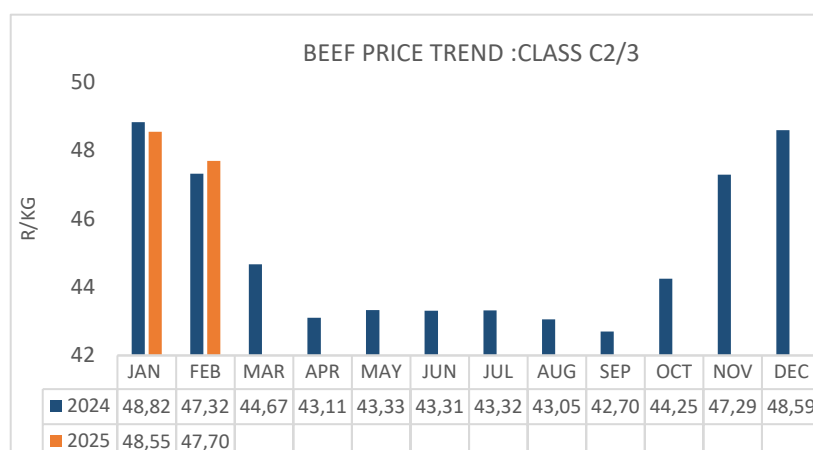
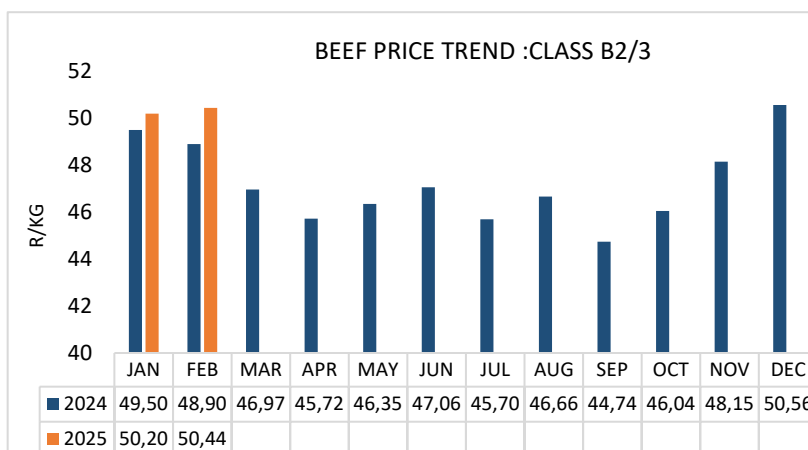


### Beef Price trend: Class A2/3

- In February 2025, the average price for Class A beef was R55,57 per kg, which is 2,4% lower than in January 2025.
- Year on year average prices for Class A increased by 2,5% in February 2025 compared to February 2024.

### Beef Price trend: Class B2/3

- In February 2025, the average price for Class B was R50,44 per kg, which is 0,5% higher than in January 2025.
- Year on year average prices for Class B are showing an increase of 3,2% between February 2025 and February 2024.

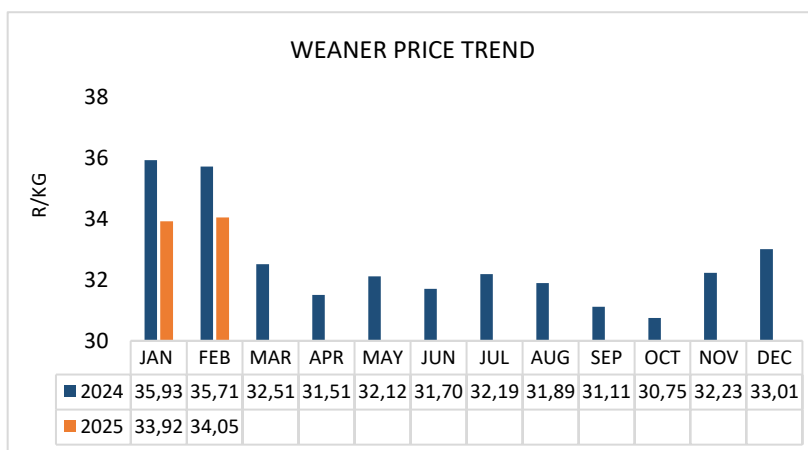


### Beef Price trend: Class C2/3

- During February 2025, average price for class C beef was R47,70 per kg, which is 1,8% lower than the previous month.
- Year on year Class C beef showed 0,8% average price increase compared to the same period last year.

### Weaner Price trend

- In February 2025, the average price for weaner calves was R34,05 per kg, which is 0,4% higher than in January 2025.
- Year on year average prices in February 2025 were 4,7 % lower than last year during the same period.
