

- February tractor sales of 638 units were approximately 21% more than the 527 units sold in February last year. Year-to-date tractor sales are now approximately 23% up on last year.
- Nineteen combine harvesters were sold in February, one more than the 18 units sold in February last year. On a year-to-date basis, combine harvester sales are now almost 8% down on last year.
- Current predictions are that tractor sales will be similar, or marginally less, than the 6 463 units sold last year. Combine harvester sales of between 180 and 190 units are expected for 2025.
