- Total of 15 325 animals sold
- Gross turnover at present R310,966 million
- Increase in average auction turnovers
- Colour variants ↗ 15,6% of total sales (in terms of numbers)




### **Observations:**

  - Waterbuck bulls



### Deviation of annual numbers from last 14 year game numbers on auctions (2012 - 2025)




