



Monthly sales trends (Source: SA Agricultural Machinery Association)





- March tractor sales of 671 units were almost 35% more than the 498 units sold in March last year. Year-to-date tractor sales are now approximately 27% up on last year.
- Thirty-seven combine harvesters were sold in March, eleven more than the 26 units sold in March last year. On a year-to-date basis, combine harvester sales are now approximately 17% up on last year.
- Current predictions are that tractor sales will be similar, or marginally more, than the 6 463 units sold last year.
- Combine harvester sales of between 180 and 190 units are expected for 2025.
