

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of poultry excluding value added tax.

During the reporting period, May 2025, average local poultry prices increased from prices recorded in April 2025. When comparing year-year prices, there is an increase in local poultry prices in May 2025 compared to the same period last year.



Frozen poultry price trend


In May 2025, average price for
Frozen poultry was R35,25 per kg,
which is 1,3% higher than in April
2025.


Year on year average prices for
Frozen poultry increased by 1,5% in
May 2025 compared to May 2024.

Fresh poultry price trend

In May 2025, the average price for Fresh poultry was
R38,34 per kg, which is 3% higher than in April 2025.

 Year on year average prices for Fresh poultry are showing an increase of 10,2% between May 2024 and May 2025.





IQF poultry price trend

• During May 2025, the average price for IQF poultry was R34, 71 per kg, which is a 2,2% price increase from April 2025.

Year on year IQF poultry showed a
14,9% average price increase
compared to same period last year.
