

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of beef and weaner calves excluding value added tax.



During the reporting period, June 2025, average local beef prices were higher (except for weaner prices) than prices recorded in the previous month. June 2025 local beef prices show an increase compared to the same period last year.



Beef Price trend: Class A2/3

- o In June 2025, the average price for Class A beef was R77 per kg, which is 13,2% higher than in May 2025.
- Year on year average prices for Class A increased by 38,9% in June 2025 compared to June 2024.





Beef Price trend: Class B2/3

- In June 2025, the average price for Class B was R60,70 per kg, which is 9,9% higher than in May 2025.
- Year on year average prices for Class B show an increase of 29% between June 2025 and June 2024.

Beef Price trend: Class C2/3

- During June 2025, the average price for class C beef was R58,64 per kg, which is 13,9% higher than the previous month.
- Year on year Class C beef showed
 35,4% average price increase
 compared to the same period last
 year.





Weaner Price trend

- In June 2025, the average price for weaner calves was R35,59 per kg, which is 2,2% lower than in May 2025.
- Year on year average prices in June 2025 were 12,3 % higher than last year during the same period.
