

PORK MONTHLY REPORT





This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of pork carcasses excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Pork - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

During the reporting period, July 2025, average local prices for pork increased from prices recorded in June 2025. When comparing year on year prices, local pork prices increased in July 2025 compared to the same period last year.





Bacon price trend

- o In July 2025, the average price for bacon pigs was R33,89 per kg, which shows a 3,6% price increase from June 2025.
- Year on year average prices for bacon pigs increased by 9,2% in July 2025 compared to July 2024.

Porker price trend

- In July 2025, the average price for porkers was R34,36 per kg, which is 2,9% higher than in June 2025.
- Year on year average prices for porkers show an increase of 8,8% between July 2024 and July 2025.





Sausage pig price trend

o In July 2025, the average price for a sausage pig was R27,51 per kg, which shows a 6,9% price increase from June 2025.

 Year on year average prices for a sausage pig show a 12,6% increase compared to the same period last year.
