1. Bachelor of Agriculture (B. Agric) Degree

Duration: 3 years | NQF Level: 7

Offered in association with Stellenbosch University

Specialisation Options:

- Plant Production
- Animal Production
- Plant and Animal Production
- Cellar Technology
- Extension and Plant Production
- Extension and Animal Production

Admission Requirements:

- National Senior Certificate (NSC) with Bachelor's Degree admission
- Minimum 55% aggregate (excluding Life Orientation)
- Minimum requirements: English/Afrikaans (50%), and Mathematics (50%)/Math Literacy (60%), and Physical Sciences/Life Sciences/Agricultural Sciences (50%)

Career Paths: Agricultural manager, wine maker, cellar manager, agricultural extension officer, researcher, trainer, or marketer.

2. Diploma in Agriculture

Duration: 3 years | NQF Level: 6

Programme Structure:

- Two years of full-time academic training
- One year of Work Integrated Learning (WIL)

Specialisation Options:

- Plant Production
- Animal Production
- Plant and Animal Production
- Cellar Technology

Admission Requirements:

- NSC with at least 40% aggregate
- Minimum requirements: English/Afrikaans (40%), and Mathematics (40%)/Math Literacy (50%), and Physical Sciences/Life Sciences/Agricultural Sciences (40%)

Career Paths: Farm assistant manager, technical advisor, cellar technician, or extension officer.

3. Equine Studies (EQASA)

Duration: 1 year

Modules Covered:

- Module 1: Professional Groom
- Module 2: Professional Head Groom
- Module 3: Professional Stable Yard Manager

Admission Requirements:

- National Senior Certificate

Key Topics: Horse care, equipment use, horse health, stable management, business skills.

Certification: EQASA-approved qualifications with progression from groom to stable yard manager.

4. Occupational Qualifications in Agricultural Skills Development

Duration: Max. 1 year

Accredited by the Quality Council for Trades and Occupations (QCTO)

Admission Requirements:

A) Orchard & Vineyard Foreman (NQF 4, OFO 110667)

- 5 years' supervisory experience on a horticultural farm (AET Level 3 literacy & numeracy), OR
- NQF 2 (Grade 10) with English & Mathematical Literacy
- Compulsory: Access to a farm for practicals Work Integrated Learning (WIL)

B) Livestock Farmer / Farm Supervisor (NQF 3, OFO 99253)

- NQF 1 (Grade 9) with English & Mathematical Literacy
- Compulsory: Access to land/farm for practicals and Work Integrated Learning (WIL)

Benefits:

- Practical, demand-driven training
- Blended learning (theory + workplace + practical)
- Fully funded by the Western Cape Department of Agriculture (excluding transport)
