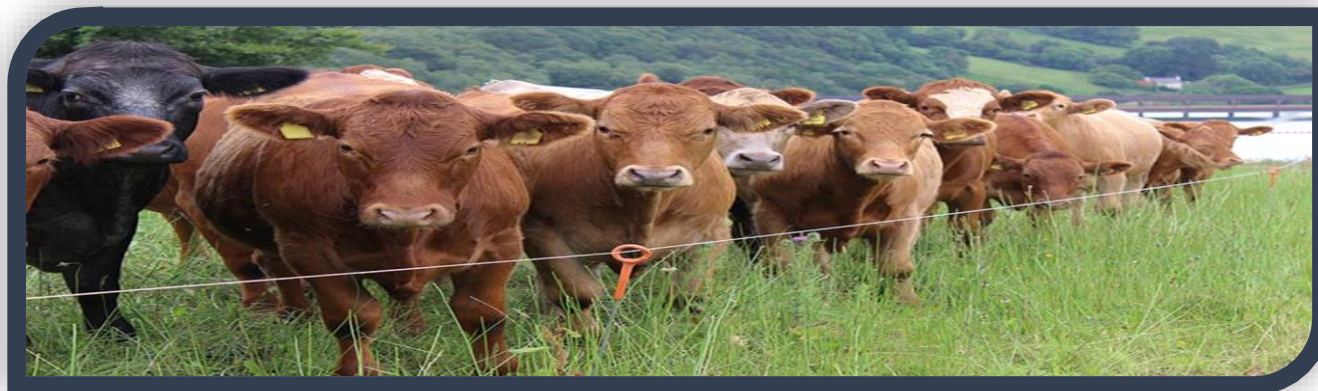


BEEF MONTHLY REPORT



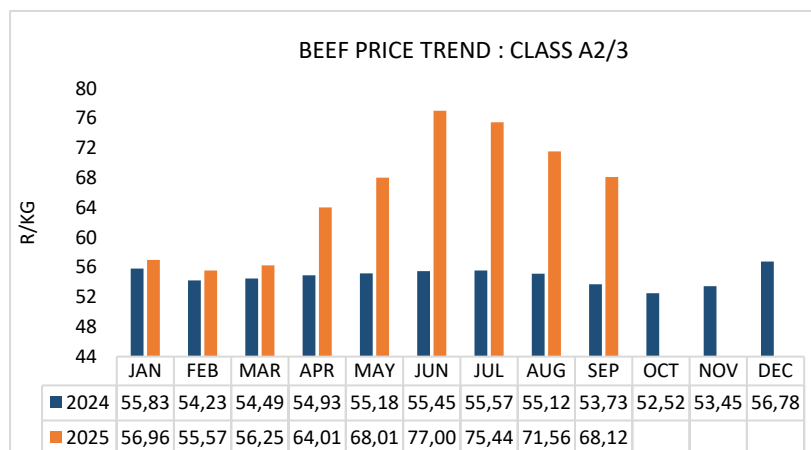

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of beef and weaner calves excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Beef- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

During the reporting period, September 2025, average local beef prices were lower than prices recorded in the previous month. September 2025 local beef prices show an increase compared to the same period last year.

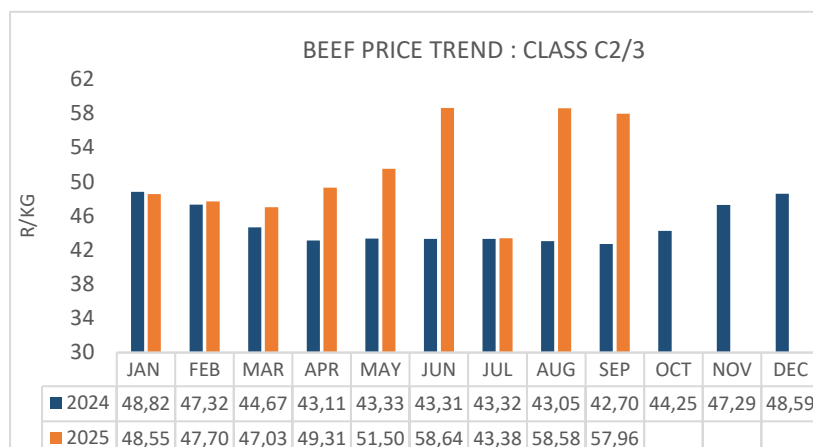
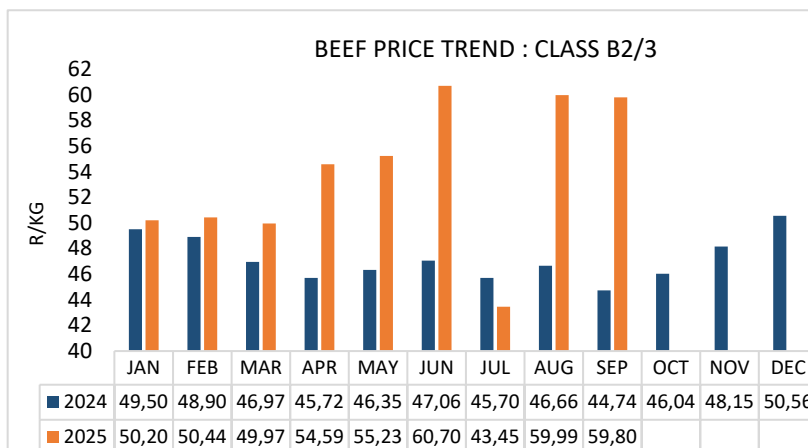


Beef Price trend: Class A2/3

- In September 2025, the average price for Class A beef was R68,12 per kg, which is 4,8 % lower than in August 2025.
- Year on year average prices for Class A increased by 26,8% in September 2025 compared to September 2024.

Beef Price trend: Class B2/3

- In September 2025, the average price for Class B was R59,80 per kg, which is 0,3% lower than in August 2025.
- Year on year average prices for Class B show an increase of 33,7% between September 2025 and September 2024.

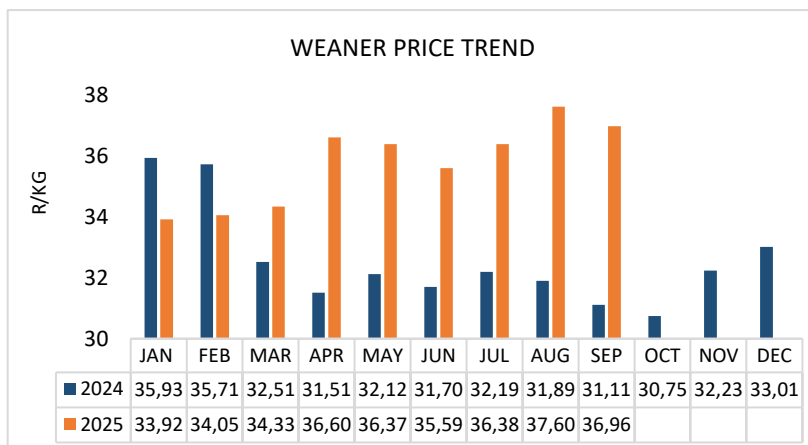


Beef Price trend: Class C2/3

- During September 2025, the average price for class C beef was R57,96 per kg, which is 1,1% lower than the previous month.
- Year on year Class C beef showed a 35,7% average price increase compared to the same period last year.

Weaner Price trend

- In September 2025, the average price for weaner calves was R36,96 per kg, which is 1,7% lower than in August 2025.
- Year on year average prices in September 2025 were 18,8 % higher than last year during the same period.
