

GOAT MONTHLY REPORT



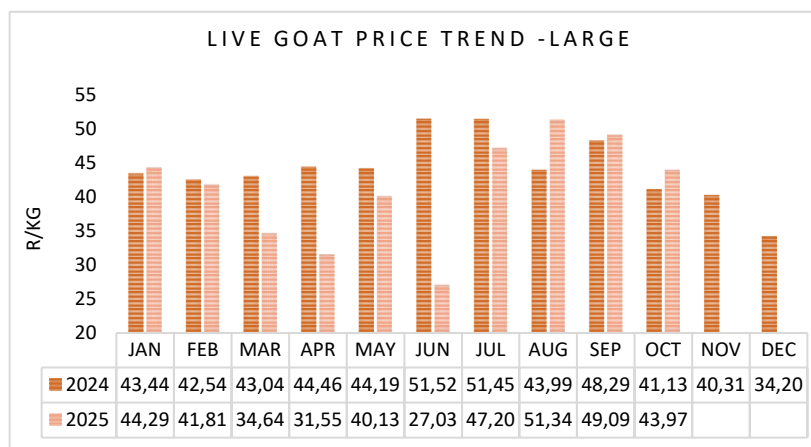
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This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of live goats excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Live goat- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

During the reporting period, October 2025, average local prices for live goats increased (Except for Large goats) from prices recorded in September 2025. When comparing year on year prices, there was an increase in local goat prices in October 2025 compared to October 2024.

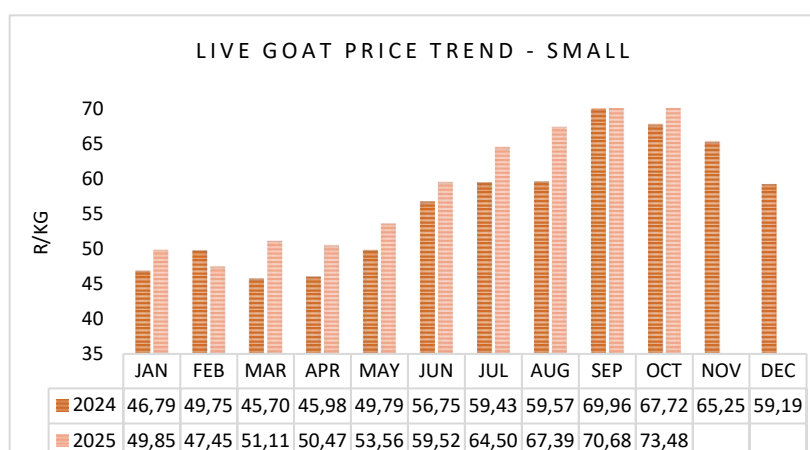
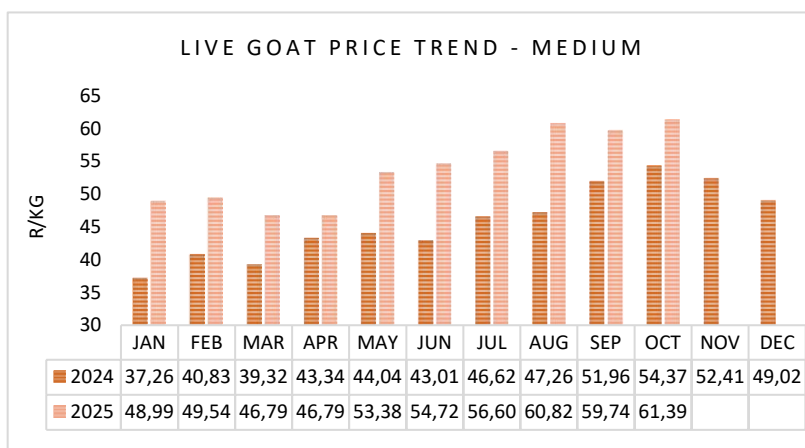


Large goat price trend

- In October 2025, the average price for a large goat was R43,97 per kg, which is 10,4% lower than in September 2025.
- Large goat prices increased by 6,9% in October 2025 compared to October 2024.

Medium goat price trend

- In October 2025, the average price for a medium goat was R61,39 per kg, which shows a 2,8% price increase from September 2025.
- Year on year average prices for a medium goat show an increase of 12,9% between October 2024 and October 2025.

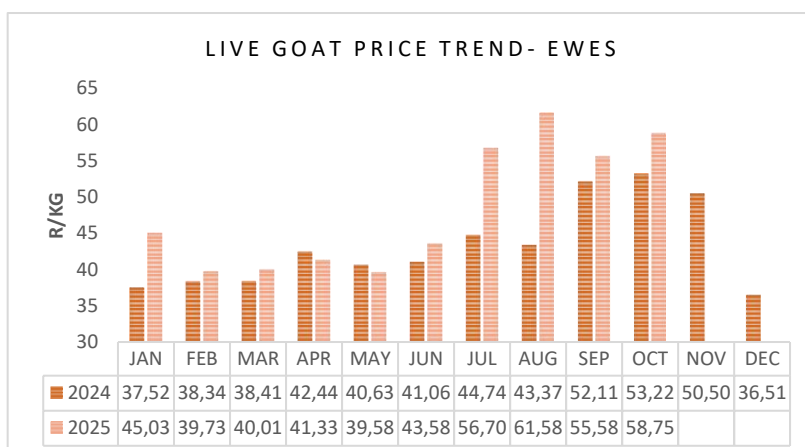


Small goat price trend

- During October 2025, average price for small goats was R73,48 per kg, which is a 4% increase from September 2025.
- Year on year small goat prices showed an 8,5% average increase compared to the same period last year.

Live goat price trend (Ewes)

- In October 2025, the average price for ewes was R58,75 per kg, which is 5,7% higher than in September 2025.
- Year on year average prices in October 2025 were 10,4% higher than the previous year.



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
