

PORK MONTHLY REPORT



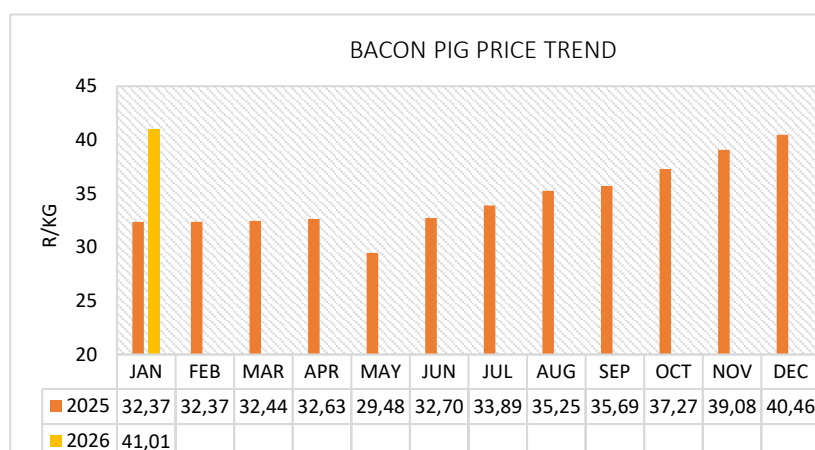

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of pork carcasses excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Pork - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

During the reporting period, January 2026, average local prices for pork increased from prices recorded in December 2025. When comparing year on year prices, local pork prices increased in January 2026 compared to the same period last year.



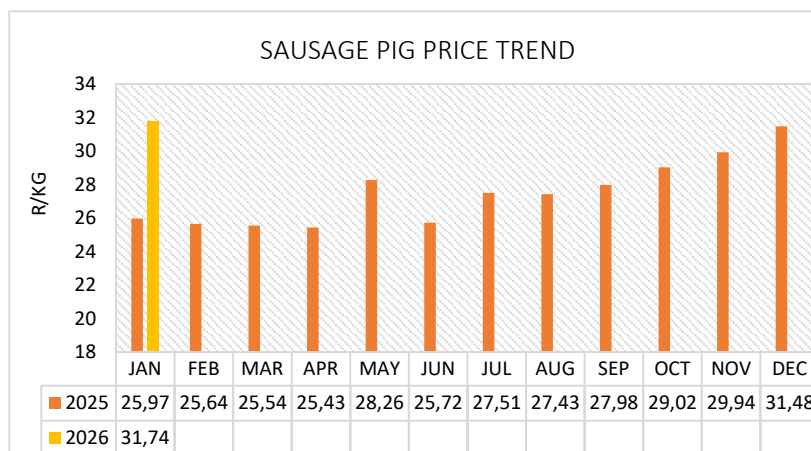
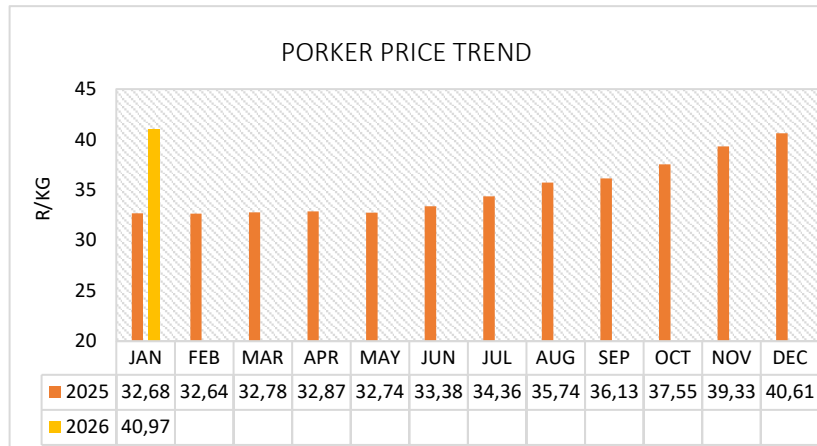
Bacon price trend

○ In January 2026, the average price for bacon pigs was R41,01 per kg, which shows a 1,3% price increase from December 2025.

○ Year on year average prices for bacon pigs increased by 26,7% in January 2026 compared to January 2025.

Porker price trend

- In January 2026, the average price for porkers was R40,97 per kg, which is 0,9% higher than in December 2025.
- Year on year average prices for porkers show an increase of 25,4% between January 2025 and January 2026.



Sausage pig price trend

- In January 2026, the average price for a sausage pig was R31,74 per kg, which shows a 0,8% price increase from December 2025.
- Year on year average prices for a sausage pig show a 22,2% increase compared to the same period last year.
