

# GOAT MONTHLY REPORT




## Issue: 2026/02

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of live goats excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Live goat- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

In February 2026, average local prices for live goats decreased (except for large and medium goats' prices) from prices recorded in January 2026. When comparing year on year prices, there was an increase (except for large goats) in local goats' prices in February 2026 compared to February 2025.





### Large goat price trend

- In February 2026, the average price for a large goat was R39,45 per kg, which is 16,1% higher than in January 2026.
- Large goat prices decreased by 5,6% in February 2026 compared to February 2025.

### Medium goat price trend

- In February 2026, the average price for a medium goat was R52,60 per kg, which is a 2,3% price increase from January 2026.
- Year on year average prices for a medium goat increased by 6,2% between February 2025 and February 2026.




### Small goat price trend

- During February 2026, average price for small goats was R53,96 per kg, which is an 11,2% decrease from January 2026.
- Year on year small goat prices showed a 13,7% average increase compared to the same period last year.

### Live goat price trend (Ewes)

- In February 2026, the average price for Ewes was R41,77 per kg, which is 16,2% lower than in January 2026.
- Year on year average prices in February 2026 were 5,1% higher than the previous year.
