




## Issue: 2026/02

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of poultry excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Poultry - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

In February 2026, average local poultry prices decreased (except for IQF poultry) from prices recorded in January 2026. When comparing year-year prices, there is an increase in local poultry prices in February 2026 compared to the same period last year.





### Frozen poultry price trend

- In February 2026, the average price for Frozen poultry was R35,23 per kg, which is 1% lower than in January 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Frozen poultry increased by 6,2% in February 2026 compared to February 2025.

### Fresh poultry price trend

- In February 2026, the average price for Fresh poultry was R39,44 per kg, which is 1,6% lower than in January 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Fresh poultry show an increase of 12,3% between February 2025 and February 2026.



### IQF poultry price trend

- In February 2026, the average price for IQF poultry was R35,50 per kg, which is a 0,1% price increase from January 2026.
- Year on year IQF poultry showed an 7,3% average price increase compared to same period last year.
