



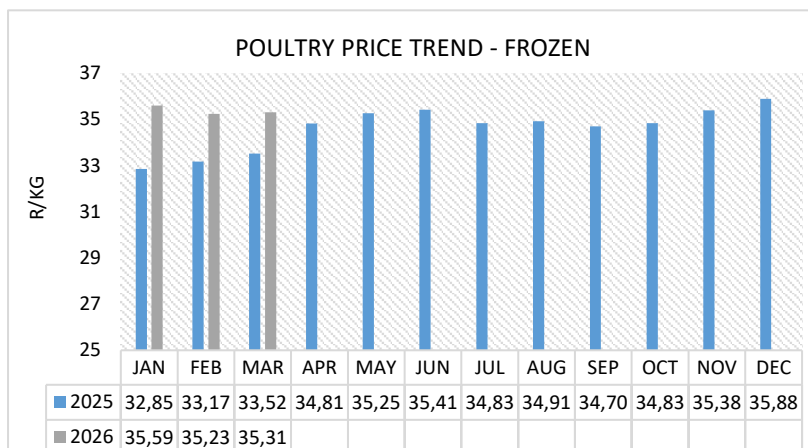

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of poultry excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Poultry - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

In March 2026, average local poultry prices increased from prices recorded in February 2026. When comparing year-year prices, there is an increase in local poultry prices in March 2026 compared to the same period last year.

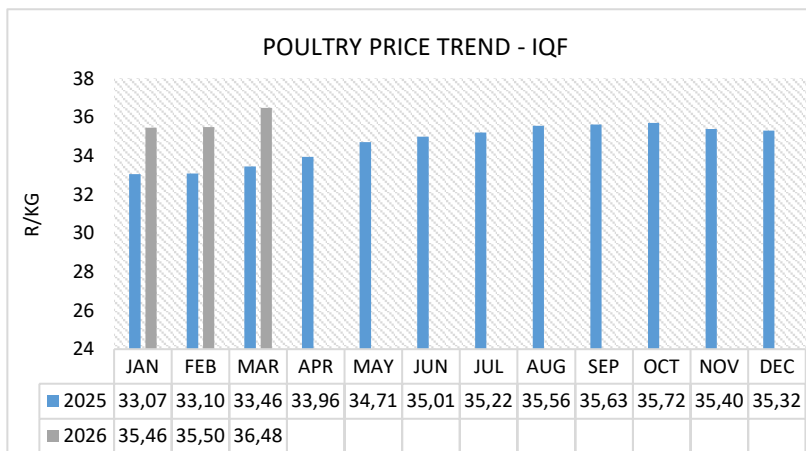
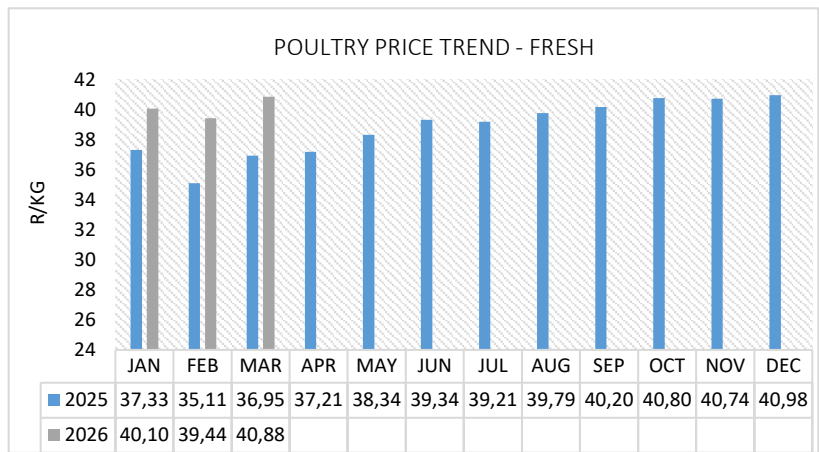


Frozen poultry price trend

- In March 2026, the average price for Frozen poultry was R35,31 per kg, which is 0,2% higher than in February 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Frozen poultry increased by 5,3% in March 2026 compared to March 2025.

Fresh poultry price trend

- In March 2026, the average price for Fresh poultry was R40,88 per kg, which is 3,6% higher than in February 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Fresh poultry show an increase of 10,6% between March 2025 and March 2026.



IQF poultry price trend

- In March 2026, the average price for IQF poultry was R36,48 per kg, which is a 2,8% price increase from February 2026.
- Year on year IQF poultry showed 9% average price increase compared to same period last year.
