

GOAT MONTHLY REPORT



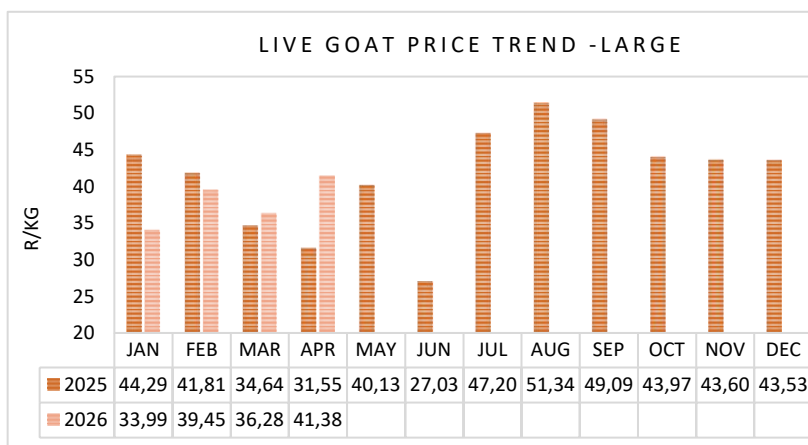

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of live goats excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Live goat- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

In April 2026, average local prices for live goats increased from prices recorded in March 2026. When comparing year on year prices, there was an increase in local goats' prices in April 2026 compared to April 2025.

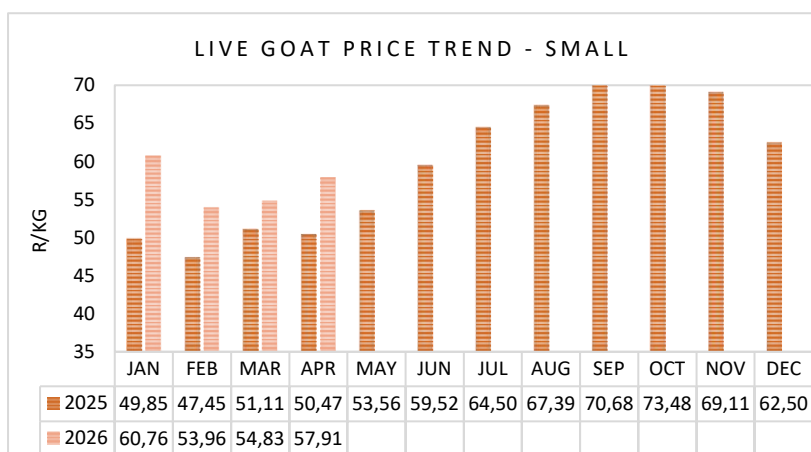
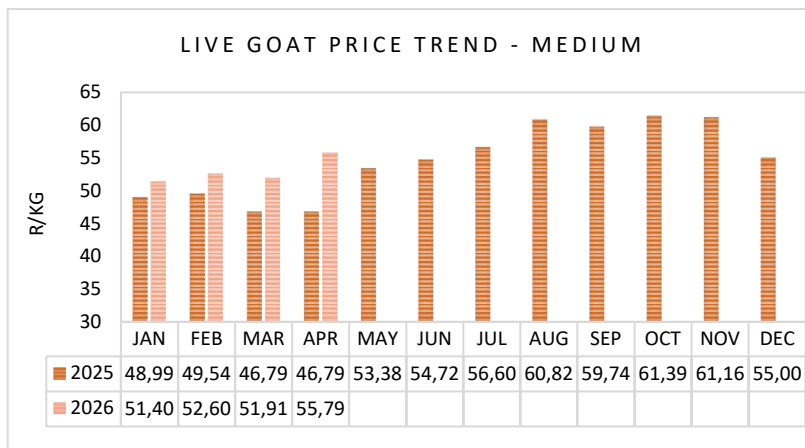


Large goat price trend

- In April 2026, the average price for a large goat was R41,38 per kg, which is 14% higher than in March 2026.
- Large goat prices increased by 31,2% in April 2026 compared to April 2025.

Medium goat price trend

- In April 2026, the average price for a medium goat was R55,79 per kg, which is a 7,5% price increase from March 2026.
- Year on year average prices for a medium goat increased by 19,2% between April 2025 and April 2026.

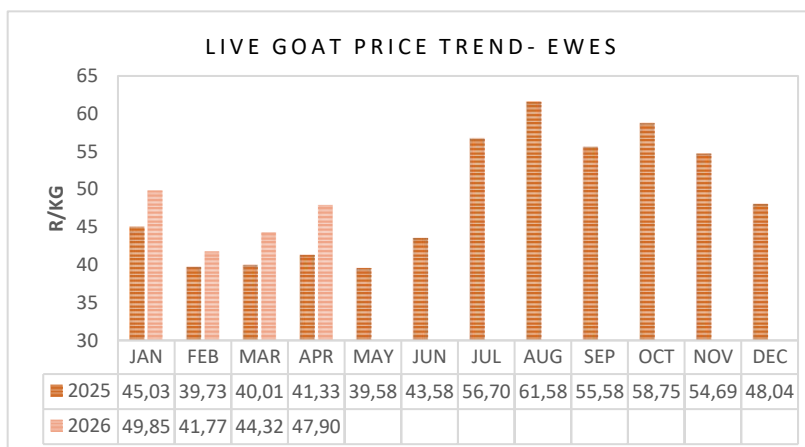


Small goat price trend

- During April 2026, average price for small goats was R57,91 per kg, which is a 5,6% increase from March 2026.
- Year on year small goat prices showed a 14,7% average increase compared to the same period last year.

Live goat price trend (Ewes)

- In April 2026, the average price for Ewes was R47,90 per kg, which is 8,1% higher than in March 2026.
- Year on year average prices in April 2026 were 15,9% higher than the previous year.
