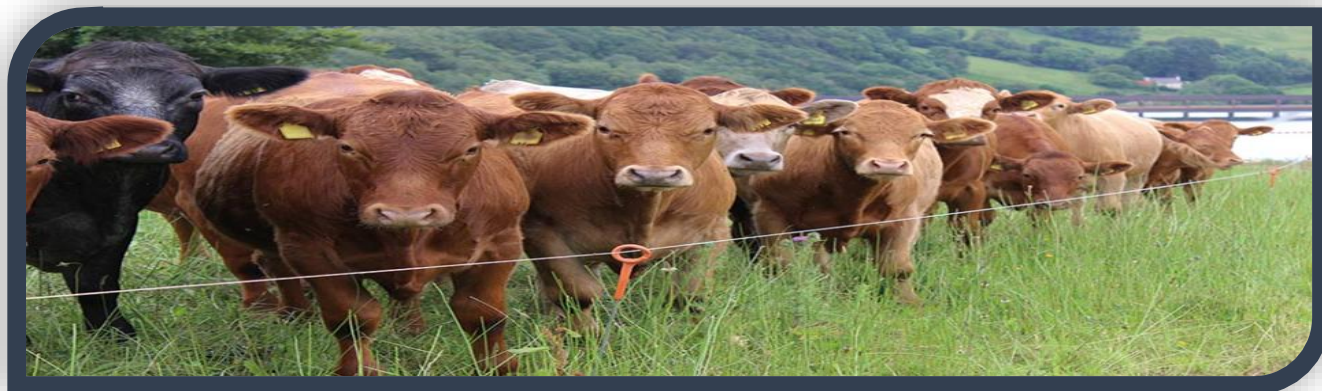


BEEF MONTHLY REPORT



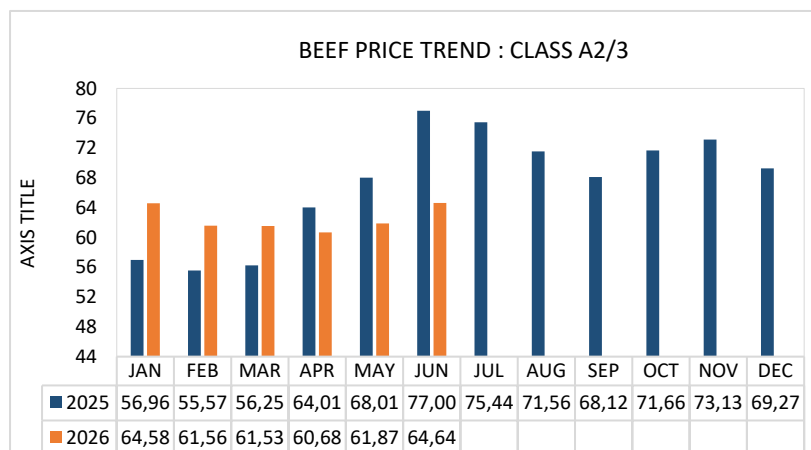

This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of beef and weaner calves excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Beef- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

During the reporting period, June 2026, average local beef prices were higher than prices recorded in the previous month. June 2026 local beef prices show an increase (except for Weaner prices) compared to the same period last year.

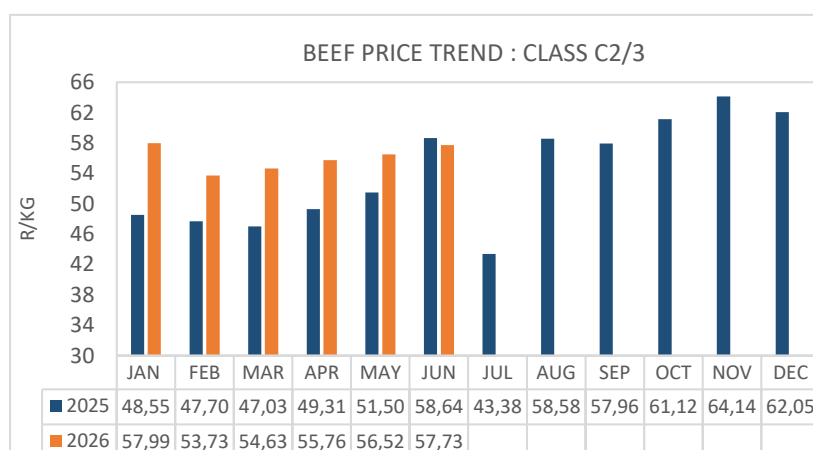
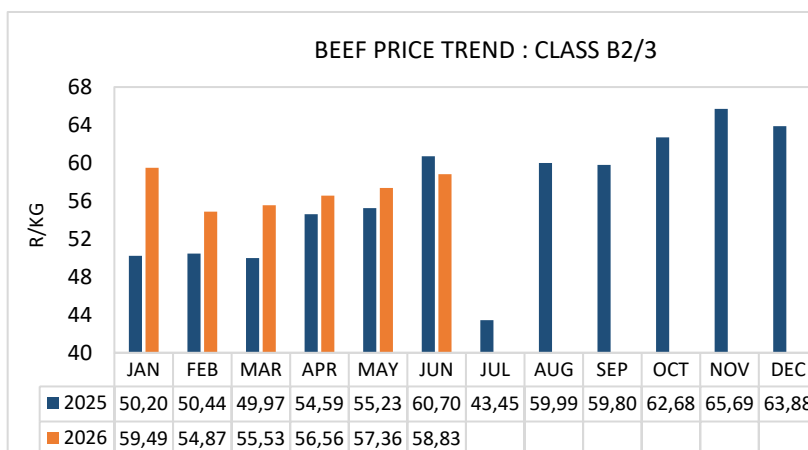


Beef Price trend: Class A2/3

- In June 2026, the average price for Class A beef was R64,64 per kg, which is 4,5% higher than in May 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Class A decreased by 16,1% in June 2026 compared to June 2025.

Beef Price trend: Class B2/3

- In June 2026, the average price for Class B was R58,83 per kg, which is 2,6% higher than in May 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Class B show a decrease of 3,1% between June 2026 and June 2025.

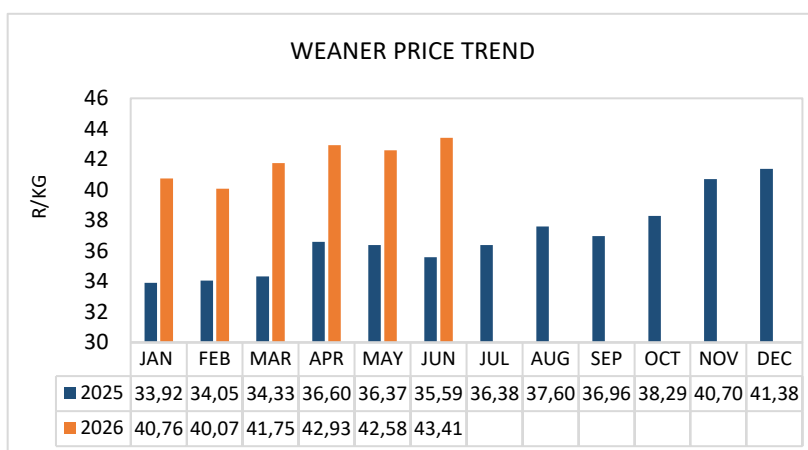


Beef Price trend: Class C2/3

- During June 2026, the average price for class C beef was R57,73 per kg, which is 2,2% higher than the previous month.
- Class C beef showed 1,5% year on year average price decrease compared to the same period last year.

Weaner Price trend

- In June 2026, the average price for weaner calves was R43,41 per kg, which is 1,9% higher than in May 2026.
- Year on year average prices in June 2026 were 22% higher than last year during the same period.



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
