

GOAT MONTHLY REPORT



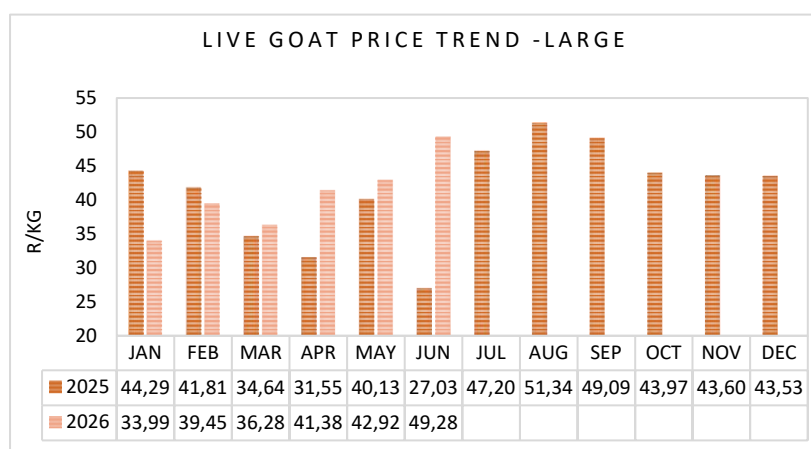
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This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of live goats excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Live goat- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

In June 2026, average local prices for live goats increased (Except Ewe prices) from prices recorded in May 2026. When comparing year on year prices, there was an increase in local goats' prices in June 2026 compared to June 2025.

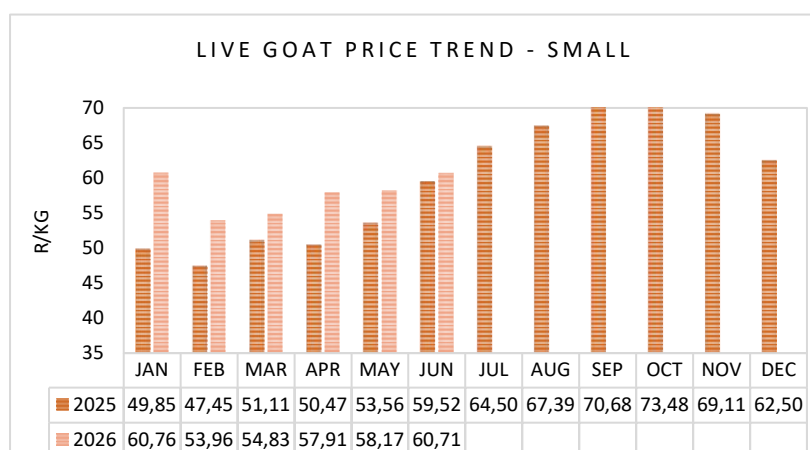
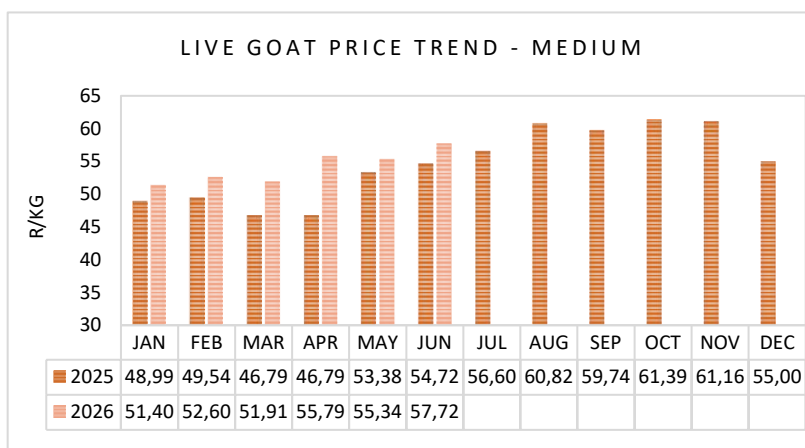


Large goat price trend

- In June 2026, the average price for a large goat was R49,28 per kg, which is 14,8% higher than in May 2026.
- Large goat prices increased by 82,3% in June 2026 compared to June 2025.

Medium goat price trend

- In June 2026, the average price for a medium goat was R57,72 per kg, which is a 4,3% price increase from May 2026.
- Year on year average prices for a medium goat increased by 5,5% between June 2025 and June 2026.

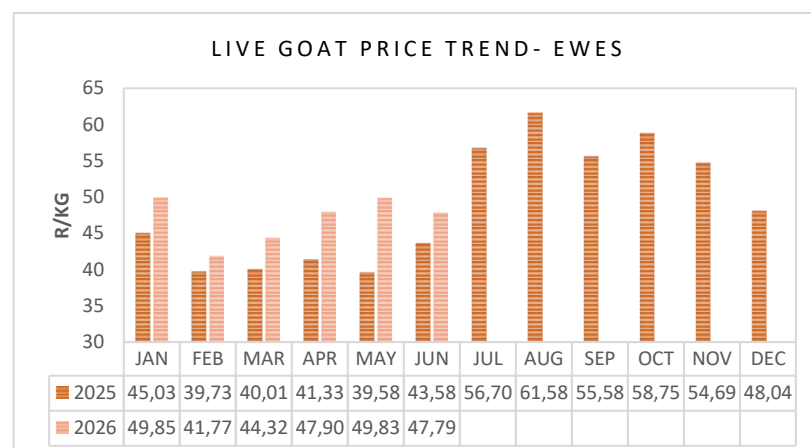


Small goat price trend

- During June 2026, average price for small goats was R60,71 per kg, which is a 4,4% increase from May 2026.
- Year on year small goat prices showed an average 2% increase compared to the same period last year.

Live goat price trend (Ewes)

- In June 2026, the average price for Ewes was R47,79 per kg, which is 4,1% lower than in May 2026.
- Year on year average prices in June 2026 were 9,7% higher than the previous year.



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
