

POULTRY MONTHLY REPORT



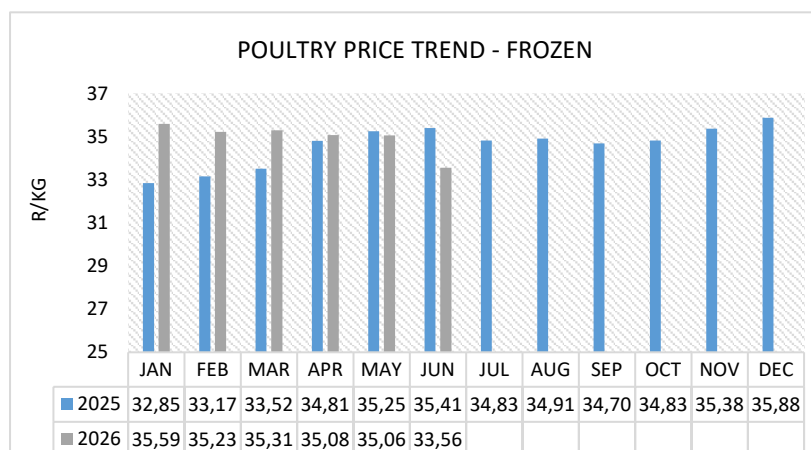
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This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of poultry excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Poultry - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

In June 2026, average local poultry prices decreased from prices recorded in May 2026. When comparing year-year prices, there is an increase (Except for Frozen Poultry) in local poultry prices in June 2026 compared to the same period last year.

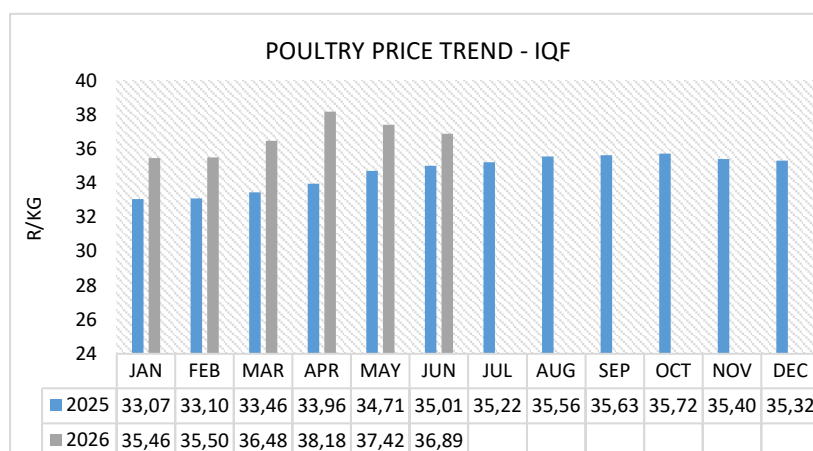
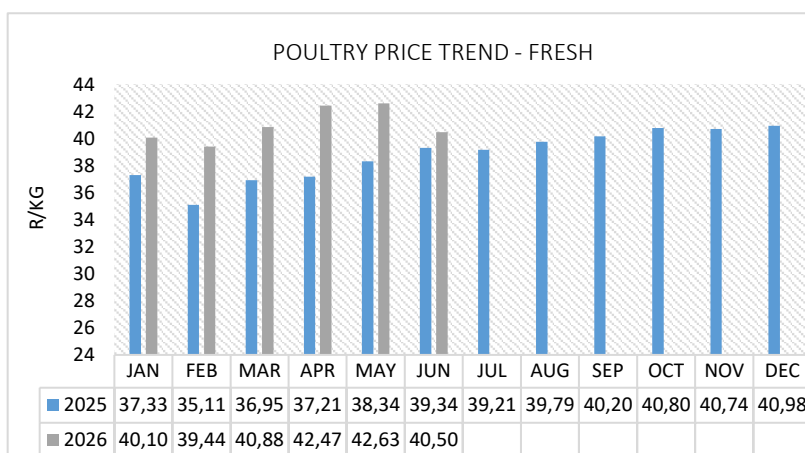


Frozen poultry price trend

- In June 2026, the average price for Frozen poultry was R33,56 per kg, which is 4,3% lower than in May 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Frozen poultry decreased by 5,2% in June 2026 compared to June 2025.

Fresh poultry price trend

- In June 2026, the average price for Fresh poultry was R40,50 per kg, which is 5% lower than in May 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Fresh poultry show an increase of 2,9% between June 2025 and June 2026.



IQF poultry price trend

- In June 2026, the average price for IQF poultry was R36,89 per kg, which is a 1,4% price decrease from May 2026.
- Year on year IQF poultry showed a 5,4% average price increase compared to same period last year.

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
